PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, because the people of Arizona deserve a state government that listens to and respects their needs, the YWCA Southern Arizona's Stand Together Arizona Training and Advocacy Center launched Operation Haboob; tasked to rebuild community, revive democracy and co-create an Arizona where everyone thrives; and

WHEREAS, YWCA Southern Arizona has pledged to foster greater inclusivity in civic participation and advocacy that supports its mission to eliminate racism, empower women, and promote peace, justice, freedom, and dignity for all; and

WHEREAS, through a statewide survey and a 3,000-mile listening tour, Arizonans said they want to trust their elected officials and be inspired by politicians beholden to constituents and not contributors; and
