#### **BOARD OF SUPERVISORS AGENDA ITEM REPORT**

Requested Board Meeting Date: September 18, 2018

Title: Cancellation of School District

#### Introduction/Background:

The Pima County School Superintendent is requesting that the Pima County Board of Supervisors cancel the attached uncontested elections for various school district governing boards.

#### Discussion:

The Superintendent of Schools has determined that these school district governing board candidates have met the statutory nomination requirements for each board candidacy. Pursuant to A.R.S. §15-424 (D) and §15-1442 (C) these uncontested governing board elections maybe cancelled by the Board of Supervisors and the individuals who filed the required nomination petitions or write-in nomination paper to fill the position will be appointed and fully vested with the powers and duties of the office as if elected.

For Empire Elementary School District, Redington Elementary School District, and San Fernando Elementary School District, where individuals did not file for one of the open seats, the seats will be declared vacant upon cancellation by the Board of Supervisors and these seats shall be filled by the County Schools Superintendent as provided in A.R.S. §15-302.

In the case of the Pima County Joint Technical Education District (JTED) - Member District 3, the cancellation of the election for this seat will be effective upon the cancellation of the same election by the Santa Cruz County Board of Supervisors. JTED Member District 3 includes the Santa Cruz Valley Unified School District No. 35 of Santa Cruz County, which required cancellation by the Santa Cruz County Board of Supervisors.

Approval of cancellation of these elections will also provide a cost savings for the eligible school districts and JTED.

#### Conclusion:

The Pima County Superintendent of Schools recommends approval for cancellation of these uncontested school district and JTED governing board elections.

#### Recommendation:

Approval of the Superintendent of Schools' recommendation for cancellation of the uncontested school district elections, the elections in Member Districts 2 and 3 of JTED, and the appointment of the qualified candidates in the attached listing.
