Project Narrative

THE STATE of Arizona, with funds appropriated by the Arizona State Legislature, has designated \$25,000.00 for the Pima County State Grants-in-Aid (SGIA) appropriation directed at Pima County Public Library (PCPL) for fiscal year 2019.

Pima County Public Library (PCPL) continues to articulate a clear vision for itself and grow as an organization. This year's emphasis will be a focus on PCPL as a healthy learning organization, as we set specific goals of excellence, superior organizational wellness and community focus.

Healthy Learning Organization

Building on SGIA projects from 2018, Pima County Public Library will take steps to build its profile as a healthy organization. Staff will use information about services, modes of operation and community happenings. As staff gather this data, they will consider as they plan for accountability -- for both achievement and impact.

Healthy Learning Organization goals involve creating

- a) more time for staff to invest time in learning, professional growth and creativity, and
- b) encouraging decision-making at the level that is closest to the customer -- whether that customer is external, or internal.

Managers and teams will participate in LeadFIT, through drop-in and as scheduled sessions. LeadFIT is hands-on, team learning that utilizes design-thinking methods while it encourages appreciative inquiry. The LeadFIT development program weighs the process and the progress equally by exploring the vision, social and situational awareness, and resource allocation (both time and human), as well as accountability and key success factors.

SGIA will support The ICAT or the Impact Capacity organizational Assessment Tool, as these planning and evaluation efforts continue. ICAT efforts will continue with a focus on informed team-building practices. Sessions will explore the neuroscience research that is illuminating what is happening in teams and organizations, reflect on how to leverage the strengths of everyone, and align around shared aspirations. Participants, whether they are managers or they participate in teams, will identify new strategies for increasing trust within their teams and for PCPL.

Pima County Public Library's executive team uses three strategic anchors to inform decision-making and focus: access, organizational strength, and community responsiveness. The Healthy Learning Organization initiative will ensure the PCPL is meeting criteria as a healthy organization, can accomplish goals and build on the aspirations of community members.
