Project Narrative

THE STATE of Arizona, with funds appropriated by the Arizona State Legislature, has designated \$25,498.00 for the City of Tucson State Grants-in-Aid (SGIA) appropriation directed at Pima County Public Library (PCPL) for fiscal year 2019.

Pima County Public Library (PCPL) will support staff development and community engagement with designated funding for the City of Tucson. SGIA funds allow the Library to be a full partner in the country's third largest book festival and demonstrate its expertise in connecting books with a community of readers. City of Tucson SGIA funds also help PCPL to advance staff learning opportunities.

PCPL at the Tucson Festival of Books

The Pima County Public Library (PCPL) will promote community engagement and social connection, and provide culturally relevant programming through the PCPL Nuestras Raíces genre track during the Tucson Festival of Books event, March 2-3, 2019 on the University of Arizona campus. As the third biggest book festival nationwide, the Tucson Festival of Books is a signature event where PCPL expands on partnerships and connects us to a community of enthusiastic readers as they explore books and meet their favorite authors. PCPL's place there secures high visibility because it attracts more than 130,000 people. There, our staff members interact with people of all ages, as they support and moderate author panels and provide other programs.

PCPL has been a partner with the Festival from the beginning. PCPL staff host talks, exhibits, and hands-on activities in the Nuestras Raíces tent – which is a Festival forum for Latina/o voices, Mexican-American cultural and literary roots, and the issues that affect our community and the Southwest region.

PCPL events include Mexican-American authors, workshops, arts and crafts; the presence of the Bookmobile, the Bookbike and nationally recognized Seed Library; and the youth-designed teen tent and teen-moderated author interviews.

Organizational Health

SGIA will also support conference attendance and internal training initiatives including online Skillsoft lessons focusing on desktop applications and best management practices, and training on workplace communication styles and giving feedback. More staff will train with the Platinum Rule Behavioral Profile Self-Assessment and the concepts presented in Radical Candor. These seminars focus on better understanding of personal working styles, and improved communication through candid praise and criticism. Both days include interactive discussion and role playing, so up to 120 more staff will learn how being direct and paying close attention to their co-workers style and their own can relate to team

building, better employee conduct, defusing conflict and managing performance expectations.

At PCPL, we hope to serve everyone, and people are important to us. SGIA funding for the City of Tucson will encourage shared learning, development, and the leveraging of existing expertise. Organizational Health initiatives ensure that Pima County will have a strong library system that will create capacity continue to bring about positive changes for the community into their future.
