Title: Certification of School District Elections

Introduction/Background:

The Pima County School Superintendent is requesting that the Pima County Board of Supervisors accept the certified School District Election results.

Discussion:

The Superintendent of Schools has received the official canvas from the Pima County Elections Department for the Altar Valley Elementary School District No. 51 Override, Catalina Foothills Unified School District No. 16 Override, Tanque Verde Unified School District No. 13 Override, Tanque Verde School District No. 13 Bond, Sahuarita Unified School District No. 30 Override, and Vail Unified School District No. 20 Bond special elections held on November 6, 2018.

The Pima County School Superintendent is responsible for conducting all school district special elections pursuant to A.R.S. § 15-302(A)(8) as the elections will not become certified until the Superintendent of Schools declares the results to the Pima County Board of Supervisors, pursuant to A.R.S. §§ 15-481(D), 15-426(B) and 15-493, and that the Board of Supervisors accept the results pursuant to A.R.S. §§ 15-426 and 15-492.

Conclusion:

The Pima County Superintendent of Schools will present the School District special election results to the Board of Supervisors, which will then certify the results.

Recommendation:

Approval of the Superintendent of Schools' declaration of the School Districts special election results.

WHEREAS, special elections for each of the aforementioned school districts were conducted on November 6, 2018 pursuant to A.R.S. §§ 15-481 and 15-491; and

WHEREAS, the Pima County Board of Supervisors officially accepted the canvass of the school district special elections pursuant to A.R.S. §§ 15-426 and 15-492, at their December 4, 2018 meeting; and


