Honorable Chair and Members of the Board of Supervisors,

As Co-Chairs of the Community Law Enforcement Partnership Commission (CLEPC), we are writing to provide you with our recommendation on two grants that the Pima County Sheriff's Department is seeking from the State of Arizona Department of Homeland Security. The first grant (A), would pay for two HD Panel X-Ray Systems totaling \$113,000.00 (GTAW 19-57), and the second grant (B), would provide 30 tactical communication headsets totaling \$28,590.00 (GTAW 19-53).

We received documents and a presentation from Pima County Sheriff's deputies at our November 3 meeting concerning the X-Ray modules and communications equipment that will be provided through these grants. The X-ray systems will replace older equipment and the headsets will provide enhanced communications and hearing protection for the Pima Regional SWAT team. None of these purchases are expected to convey additional costs to the Pima County taxpayer.

Commissioners voted 8 to 2 to recommend the Board of Supervisors accept the two grants.
