RESOLUTION NO. 18-33 OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOUTH TUCSON, ARIZONA, APPROVING AND ADOPTING AN AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT [IGA] AMONG S.W.A.T. ["LAW ENFORCEMENT PARTICIPATING JURISDICTIONS"] TO AMEND ARTICLE V TO EXTEND THE TERM OF THE AGREEMENT AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THE AMENDMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY TO EXIST

WHEREAS, the Law Enforcement Participating Jurisdictions of Pima County, City of South Tucson, Town of Oro Valley, Town of Marana, Town of Sahuarita, Pascua Yaqui Tribe, and the Tucson Airport Authority entered into a collective agreement to form and operate the Pima County Regional S.W.A.T. Team; and

WHEREAS, the CITY passed and adopted a Resolution to approve the IGA/Contract and to authorize the CITY to participate with other Law Enforcement Participating Jurisdictions in the prescribed activities; and

WHEREAS, the CITY and the other Law Enforcement Participating Jurisdictions have the authority to enter into agreements for services pursuant to A.R.S. §§ 11-951, 11-952, and 48-805, if authorized by their legislative or governing bodies; and

WHEREAS, it is the mutual desire of the parties to Amend the IGA/Contract to extend the IGA/Contract's termination date to April 14, 2023 as presented to Mayor and Council; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the City of South Tucson desire to have this Resolution presented at its March 11, 2013 Council Meeting for the purpose of approving and adopting the Amendment to the IGA/Contract; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council have determined that formal action on this Resolution is in the best interest of the CITY and its citizens; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the preservation of the peace, health, and safety of the City of South Tucson, Arizona, that an emergency be declared to exist to assure timely implementation of this Amendment, and that this Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF SOUTH TUCSON, **ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1: That the CITY formally approves this Resolution for the purpose of approving and adopting the Amendment to the IGA/Contract with the Law Enforcement Participating Jurisdictions for services as outlined in the IGA/Contract and the Amendment.

Section 2: That the immediate operation of the provisions of this Resolution is necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the City of South Tucson, Arizona.

Section 3: That the Mayor is authorized and empowered to execute this Resolution and the Amendment to the Intergovernmental Agreement Document as presented.

SAHUARITA RESOLUTION NO. 2018-0545

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF SAHUARITA, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING THE TOWN TO ENTER INTO AMENDMENT NUMBER THREE TO SAHUARITA CONTRACT NO. CO08-0041, THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH PIMA COUNTY FOR FORMATION OF A REGIONAL S.W.A.T. TEAM, AS AMENDED, FOR THE PURPOSE OF AMENDING THE EXISTING AGREEMENT TO EXTEND THE TERM OF THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT FOR ONE (1) FIVE-YEAR TERM, AT NO ADDITIONAL COST TO THE TOWN BEYOND THE ORIGINAL \$150,000.00 AMOUNT OF THE INITIAL INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT.

WHEREAS, on December 10, 2007, by adoption of Resolution No. 2007-99, the Town of Sahuarita was authorized to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement ("Agreement") with Pima County and multiple regional jurisdictions for the purpose of forming a Regional S.W.A.T. Team; and

WHEREAS, on April 12, 2010, by adoption of Resolution No. 2010-178, the Town of Sahuarita was authorized to enter into Amendment No. One to the Agreement for the purpose of including a bomb squad element; to add termination language; and to add language allowing the Agreement and amendments thereto be signed in counterparts; and

WHEREAS, on July 8, 2013, by adoption of Resolution No. 2013-352, the Town of Sahuarita was authorized to enter into Amendment No. Two to the Agreement for the purpose of extending the term of the Agreement for an additional five years at no additional cost to the Town beyond the original \$150,000.00 amount of the initial Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the parties further wish to amend the Agreement for the purpose of extending the term of Agreement for an additional five years, to April 14, 2023, as provided for in Article V of the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Sahuarita currently participates in the Pima Regional S.W.A.T. Team under the terms of the Agreement between the Town, County and other regional jurisdictions; and

WHEREAS, the Sahuarita Police Department is an active participant in the Pima Regional S.W.A.T. Team; and

WHEREAS, extending the Agreement will not result in an additional cost to the Town beyond the \$150,000.00 amount as provided for in the initial Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Town of Sahuarita, Arizona, as follows:

- Section 1. The Town is hereby authorized to enter into Contract Amendment No. Three to Sahuarita Contract No. CO08-0041 for the purpose of extending the term of the Agreement to April 14, 2023. A copy of Amendment No. Three is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference.
- Section 2 The Mayor of the Town of Sahuarita is hereby authorized and directed to execute said Agreement on behalf of the Town of Sahuarita.
- **Section 3.** The Town staff is hereby authorized and directed to take all steps necessary to implement said Agreement and give it effect.
- Section 4. The various Town officers and employees are authorized and directed to perform all acts necessary or desirable to give effect to this Resolution and sections of the Town Code.
- Section 5. All ordinances, resolutions, or motions and parts of ordinances, resolutions or motions of the council in conflict with the provisions of this Resolution are hereby repealed, effective as of the effective date of this Resolution. All internal references within the Town Code to any affected provision are hereby updated.
- **Section 6.** If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Resolution is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

RESOLUTION NO. C07-140-18

RESOLUTION APPROVING AN AMENDMENT TO THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH VARIOUS PIMA COUNTY LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES FOR PARTICIPATION IN A REGIONAL SPECIAL WEAPONS AND TACTICS TEAM

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is the governing body of the Pascua Yaqui Tribe and has the authority to negotiate and enter into agreements with federal, state, and local governments on behalf of the Tribe (Article VI, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the Pascua Yaqui Tribe); and

- WHEREAS, the Pascua Yaqui Tribe, by Resolution No. C12-194-07, entered into an Intergovernmental Agreement with Pima County, the Town of Oro Valley, the Town of Marana, the City of South Tucson, the Town of Sahuarita, and the Tucson Airport Authority to form a Regional Special Weapons and Tactics (SWAT) Team, effective April 15, 2008 through April 14, 2013; and
- WHEREAS, the Pima County Regional SWAT Agreement was renewed for the period of April 15, 2013 through April 14, 2018; and
- WHEREAS, the Pascua Yaqui Police Department recommends that the Tribal Council approve an Amendment extending the term of the Pima County Regional SWAT Agreement through April 14, 2023; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council continues to believe that the Pima County Regional SWAT Agreement is in the best interest of the Tribe and the Pascua Yaqui Police Department; and
- WHEREAS, the Office of the Attorney General approves to form the Amendment to the Pima County Regional SWAT Agreement (incorporated herein by this reference) extending the term of the Agreement for the period of April 15, 2018 through April 14, 2023.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE PASCUA YAQUI TRIBE that the Tribal Council hereby (1) approves the Amendment to the Pima County Regional SWAT Agreement, substantially in the form attached hereto, effective April 15, 2018 through April 14, 2023; (2) authorizes the Chairman to execute the Amendment and any extensions or amendments thereto that extend funding or make nonsubstantive changes to the Amendment on behalf of the Tribe; and (3) authorizes the Chairman to take necessary and proper action to execute, implement, and enforce the Amendment and this Resolution.
