ARTICLE I NAME & LOCATION

The name of the organization shall be the Arivaca Christian Center, Inc., located at 17085 West Third (3rd) Street in the town of Arivaca, in the county of Pima, in the state of Arizona.

ARTICLE II STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

The purpose of the Arivaca Christian Center is to contribute to the development of the Christian faith and promote the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

ARTICLE III MEMBERSHIP

Sections 1: The charter members of the organization shall be those persons, who founded the Arivaca Christian Center, Inc.

Section 2: Members shall be those who profess a belief in Jesus Christ, attend Church Services, contribute to and participate in the activities of the church.

Section 3: Whenever people present themselves as candidates for membership under the conditions set forth in Section two (2) above, they shall be accepted as members.

ARTICLE IV GOVERNING BOARD OF CHURCH

Section 1: All members of the Board of Directors shall be chosen by a majority vote of the congregation and shall be the ~~officers~~ *Directors* for the Board of Directors and the Corporation.

Section 2: Officers shall:

- A. Consist of a President, Vice-President, Recording Secretary, and Treasurer.
- B. Be elected by the Board of Directors from board members selected by the congregation.
- C. Appoint additional officers as needed to assist elected officers in their duties. If there are appointed officers, they shall be known as assistants.

Section 3: Duties of Officers

A. President

The President shall:

- 1. Be the chief executive officer of Arivaca Christian Center, Inc.
- 2. Serve as chairman of the Board of Directors
- 3. Have the power to appoint special committees subject to the approval of the Board of Directors
- 4. Serve as ex officio member of all committees except the nominating committee; and
- 5. Be granted reimbursement for any expenses incurred in the performance of his duties.

B. Vice President

The Vice-President shall assume the duties of the president in the absence of the President and shall assist the President in his efforts for the good of the organization.

C. Recording Secretary shall:

1. Keep accurate minutes of all Board of Directors, Congregational and Special meetings of the church.
2. Keep the seal of the Church in a safe place.
3. Preside at meetings when the President and Vice President are absent.

D. Treasurer shall:

1. Be responsible for the collections, receipts and deposits of financial contributions and income into accounts at such banks and financial institutions as the Board of Directors shall direct.
2. Keep accurate records of all receipts and expenditures of the organization.
3. Present a monthly report to the Board of Directors
4. Request an annual audit of the organization's financial records.

E. Appointed Officers

Appointed Officers shall have such duties as the Board of Directors shall direct. (See Section 3B)

Section 3. Election and Appointment of Officers

A. Elected Officers Shall:

1. Be elected by ballot at the annual meeting.
(See Article IV Section 1)
2. Take office following the adjournment of the meeting at which they are elected unless otherwise specified.
3. Shall serve a term of two years.

B. Appointed Officers

1. Appointed officers may be appointed at any time by the Board of Directors (See Article IV Section 1) and shall take office immediately upon notification of appointment. The term of office for appointed officers shall be determined by the Board of Directors, but in no instance shall the term exceed that of the officers they are assisting or replacing.

C. Vacancies in Office:

Except for the office of President, vacancies in office shall be filled by the Board of Directors for the remainder of the term vacated.

ARTICLE V

MEETINGS

Section 1. Regular meetings

Regular meetings shall be held once each month on a day selected by the Board of Directors.

Section 2. Annual Meeting

One meeting in January shall be selected as the annual meeting for the purpose of electing directors, receiving reports of officers, receiving reports of the Board of Directors and committees, and for any other business which shall properly come before the congregation. Notice of annual meetings shall include an agenda and shall be announced in church (3) weeks prior to the date of the meeting.

Section 3. Special Meetings

- A. Special meetings of the membership may be called by the Board of Directors, provided that notice of such meetings shall be given to members at least seven (7) days prior to the date of the meeting. Notice shall include the specific business to be conducted at the meeting.
- B. Special meetings of the Board of Directors may be called by any member of the board provided earnest effort is made to notify all board members prior to the meeting and business to be discussed is included in that notification. Board members may vote by proxy by telephone (or by e-mail) if unable to attend such meetings.

Section 4. Quorum

- A. At membership meetings: The quorum for any congregational meetings shall be ten percent (10%) of the total membership, provided that at least Three (3) directors are present.
- B. Board of Director meetings: A quorum for meetings of the Board of Directors shall be a majority of the Directors then in office.

ARTICLE VI BOARD OF DIRECTORS AND PERSONNEL

Section 1. Composition:

The Board of Directors shall consist of the elected and appointed officers: A total of no less than three (3) and up to nine directors, always consisting of an uneven number.

Section 2. Responsibilities:

The Board of Directors shall:

- A. Be responsible for the management and administration of all Arivaca Christian Center, Inc., business.
- B. Be the Board of Directors of the corporation.
- C. Determine the compensation for personnel and/or consultants retained by the organization.

D. Have the power to conduct the business of the organization except that which is retained by the membership as provided by these bylaws.

Section 3. Vacancies:

Vacancies among directors shall be filled by the Board of Directors for the remainder of the terms vacated. (See Article IV, Section 3C)

ARTICLE VII COMMITTEES

Section 1. Standing Committees: There shall be the following standing committees: Building and Grounds, Membership, Nominating.

Section 2. Special Committees: Special Committees may be created by the Board of Directors as deemed necessary.

Section 3. Appointments: Except for the Nominating Committee, the President shall appoint the chairmen and members of standing and special committees with the approval of the Board of Directors.

Section 4. Nominating Committee: The Nominating Committee shall consist of three (3) members elected at the annual meeting as needed. The Committee shall choose it's own chairman, nominate candidates for each office to be filled, and report to the Board of Directors at least one month prior to the annual meeting.

ARTICLE ~~IX~~ VIII PARLIAMENTARY AUTHORITY

VACANCY OF THE
BOARD OF DIRECTORS TO BE FILLED

The rules contained in the current edition of Robert's Rule of Order Newly Revised shall govern Arivaca Christian Center, Inc., where they are applicable.

ARTICLE IX AMENDMENTS

Section 1. Amendments. The bylaws may be amended at any congregational meeting provided notice has been given one month in advance. Amendments shall require a two-thirds vote of the current members present.

Section 2. Effective date of amendments shall be the adjournment of the meeting at which they are adopted unless otherwise provided.

ARTICLE X STAFF

Section 1. The staff shall consist of those selected by the Board of Directors to maintain the church. No staff shall be employed or retained over the objections of the Board of Directors.

Section 2. Minister(s)

A. A minister shall be chosen and called by the Church from candidates submitted by the nominating committee when a vacancy or need occurs. The



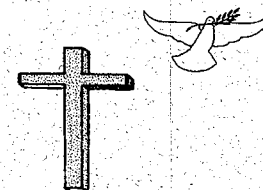

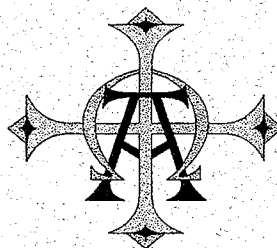
Church Philosophy

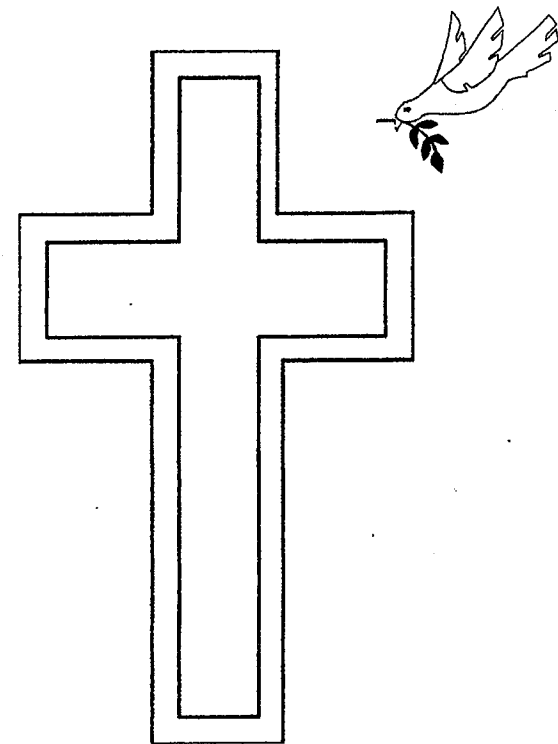

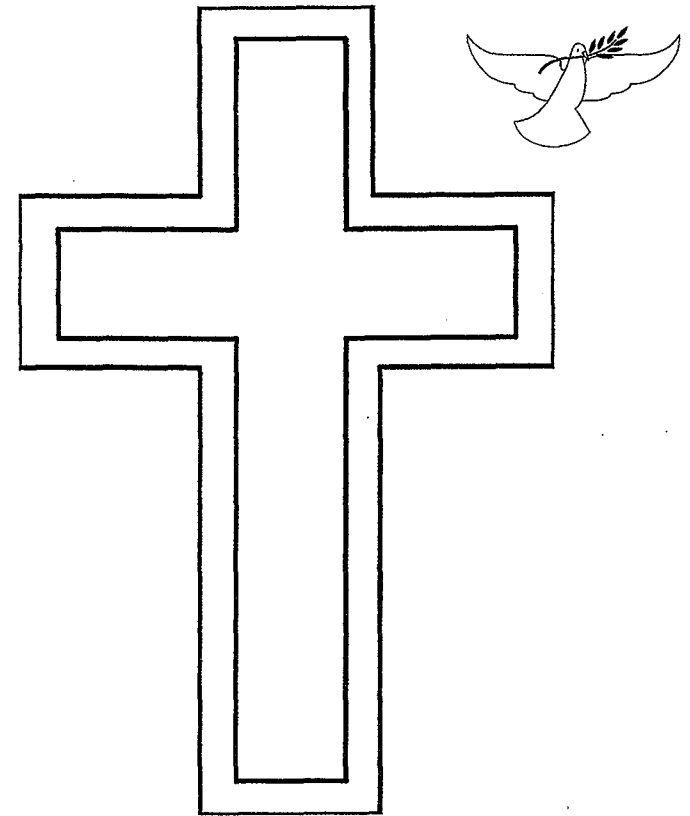

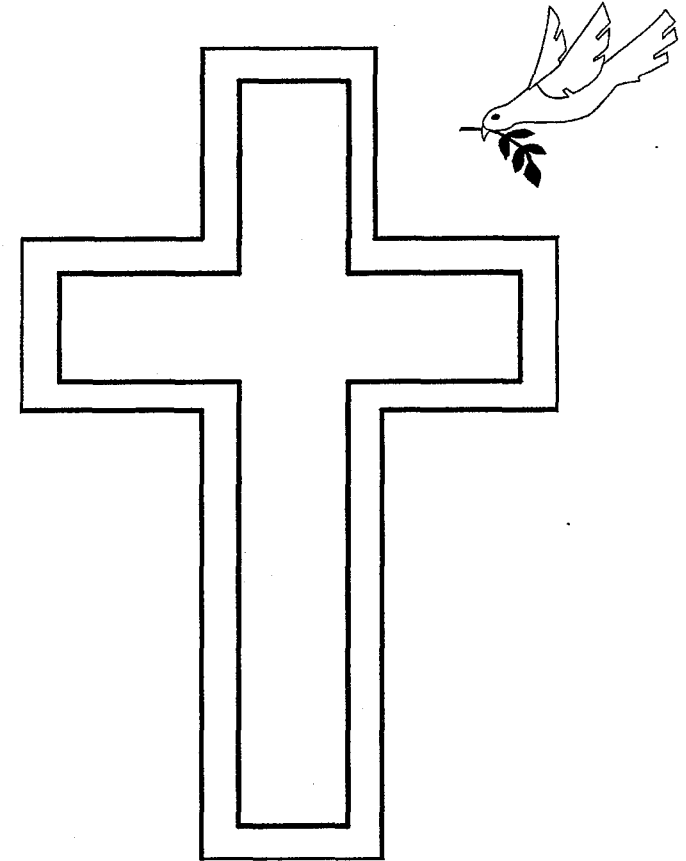
