***Project Title/Description:**

United States Housing and Urban Development (USHUD) Continuum of Care (CoC) Program - Project Advent. The contract and amendments can be found in OnBase by searching Contracts 16*304 in Doc_ID_AMS.

***Purpose:**

USHUD has awarded additional CoC Program funds for an additional year of services to the homeless. This amendment is provide additional funds and to extend the contract with Salvation Army, a subrecipient of this program, for the period of July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020.

A standardized referral process is used to match participants to the Pima County Sullivan Jackson Employment Center (SJEC). Program participants then enter Rapid Rehousing through Salvation Army. Once housing is stabilized, Salvation Army case managers work with participants to place them into housing. SJEC then begins to work with participants to obtain full-time employment. After clients find work, they begin to contribute toward the rent with the goal of becoming self-sufficient within six months.

***Program Goals/Predicted Outcomes:**

Salvation Army will provide Rapid-Rehousing to a minimum of 30 participants (a homeless family is considered one participant).

***Public Benefit:**

This amendment supports the economic development by helping to develop a trained and productive labor force and reduce homelessness in Pima County.

***Metrics Available to Measure Performance:**

As a USHUD program, metrics are measured through the Homeless Management Information System (HMIS).

***Retroactive:**

Yes. Due to delays in getting signatures from Salvation Army. If the amendment is not approved, supportive services and rental assistance will not be provided to the homeless in Pima County.

AMENDMENT FOUR

The parties agree to amend the above-referenced Contract as follows:

1. BACKGROUND AND PURPOSE.

- 1.1. Background. On May 17, 2016, Pima County (“County”) and Salvation Army (“Awardee”), entered into the above referenced contract to provide supportive services and rental assistance to the homeless in Pima County.
- 1.2. Purpose.
 - 1.2.1. The United States Housing and Urban Development (“HUD”) funds this Contract and has awarded additional Continuum of Care (“COC”) Program funds to County for an additional year of Project Advent case management, housing assistance, transportation and other supportive housing services to the homeless.
 - 1.2.2. The Pima County Board of Supervisors finds that it is in the best interests of the residents of Pima County to provide an additional year of Project Advent services for the homeless.
 - 1.2.3. Pursuant to HUD guidelines, Awardee is a “Subrecipient” of these CoC Program funds and will conduct all activities under this Agreement accordingly.

2. TERMS AND EXTENSIONS, SECTION 1.0, paragraph 1.1 is amended as follows:

2.1. The termination date is changed:

FROM: June 30, 2019

TO: June 30, 2020

2.2. The number of available renewals is changed:

FROM: two (2) additional years or any portion thereof

TO: one (1) additional year or any portion thereof

3. COMPENSATION AND PAYMENT, SECTION 3.0 is amended as follows:

3.1. Paragraph 3.1, the table is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

July 1, 2018 – June 30, 2019	\$140,289.00

3.2. Paragraph 3.13 is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

3.13 Changes between budget line items. Changes between budget line items of no more than 15% may be granted by and at the sole discretion of the Director of Community Services Employment and Training (“CSET”) or designee. The following provisions apply:

3.13.1. The change may not increase or decrease the maximum allocated amount.

3.13.2. Agency must submit a written request for the line item change on or before May 15 of the contract year. The written request must contain a detailed explanation of:

3.13.2.1. The reason the change is necessary; and

3.13.2.2. How the specified purpose, program(s), metrics, or outcomes set forth in this Agreement will continue to be met, despite the requested change.

3.13.3. The change must be for future expenditures that are not part of the current existing and approved budget(s). The change may not be to cover unbudgeted expenditures incurred by Agency prior to written approval of the request for a budget line item change.

3.13.4. If the Director of CSET or designee approves the request for the budget line item change, the change will not be effective, nor will compensation under the change be provided, until the date set forth in the written approval.

3.3. Paragraph 3.14 is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

Any change that increases or decreases the maximum allocated amount or that changes the Scope of Work in any way will require a contract amendment. Such change will not be effective, nor will compensation under the change be provided, until the contract amendment is fully executed by both parties.

3.4. Paragraph 3.15 is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

Goods and services provided in excess of the budgeted line item or the maximum allocated amount without prior authorization as set forth in paragraphs 3.13 and 3.14 above will be at Agency’s own risk.

3.5. **Paragraph 3.16.1**, the first sentence, is deleted and replaced with the following:

Pursuant to 2 CFR §2400.101, unless excepted under 24 CFR chapters I through IX, the cost principles set forth in 2 CFR part 200, Subpart E, as may be modified by amendments and additions, will be used to determine whether reimbursement of an incurred cost will be reimbursed under this Agreement.

4. **COMPLIANCE WITH LAWS, SECTION 6.0, paragraph 6.2.3** is amended to read:

Lobbying to influence the outcome of any election or the award of any federal contract, grant, loan or cooperative agreement (see Federal Standard Form LLL, "Disclosure of Lobbying Activities);

4. **ISRAEL BOYCOTT CERTIFICATION, SECTION 33.0** is deleted in its entirety.

5. **EXHIBIT A – SCOPE OF WORK**, is amended as follows:

5.1 **PROGRAM ACTIVITIES – COUNTY, SECTION 3 – paragraph 3.1** is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

Determine eligibility of individuals and households seeking CoC services. Based on the information available in the Pima County Coordinated Entry System, refer eligible individuals or households, as appropriate, to Awardee for Project Advent services.

5.2 **PROGRAM GOALS/PREDICTED OUTCOMES, SECTION 5, paragraph 5.1**, the table is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

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5.3 **BUDGET, SECTION 6, paragraph 6.1**, is amended to add:

For services provided **July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020**, Awardee will be paid in accordance to the following table:
