CT 137789 - Agreement Between USACOE & Flood Control

*Purpose:

Increment 3 was removed from the bid set for the last phase of the Arroyo Chico project. The last piece of this 30-year long project is the channel improvements between Campbell Avenue and Parkway Terrace known by the USACE as Phase 2b, Increment 3. Increment 3 was delayed as the Regional Flood Control District (District) tried to argue that this portion of the project did not need to be constructed. The USACE requires this segment in order to complete and close the Arroyo Chico project.

The District is working with the USACE to value engineer a channel solution that will have the least impact and provide the most flood risk mitigation. Following completion of this phase of the project, cost share reconciliation for all phases of the project will be completed. Funding necessary to complete the project and reach project close is \$3,500,000.

The District as the local sponsor is required to provide a 35% cost share. Our anticipated expenditures to finalize the project is \$3,500,000.

A RESOLUTION OF THE PIMA COUNTY FLOOD CONTROL DISTRICT BOARD OF DIRECTORS APPROVING ADDITIONAL FUNDING FOR THE FINAL PHASE OF THE ARROYO CHICO DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT (District 2)

The Board of Directors for the Pima County Regional Flood Control District finds:

- The Arroyo Chico Drainage Improvement Project ("the Project") is a multi-year federally funded project that the Pima County Regional Flood Control District ("District"), as the Local Sponsor, initiated with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers ("ACOE") in 1999 under Federal Contract Number 01-04-125833-0499, and continued under Contract Number 01-59-U-137789-0406 ("CT 14*198"), and
- 2. The Project was authorized by Section 101 (a)(5) of the Water Resources Development Act of 1999 (WRDA 1999) and Public Law 106-53 to provide flood protection improvements within the central area of the City of Tucson which included the Arroyo Chico Wash and its tributaries, and
- 3. The final phase of the Project ("Increment 3") is the construction of Channel Improvements upstream of Campbell Avenue, and
- 4. The District's local share of the Increment 3 proposed by ACOE is \$4,000,000.00 including \$304,250.00 of contingency funds,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that:

- The Board hereby approves the addition of \$3,500,000.00 to Increment 3 of the Tucson Drainage Area Project, which represents \$3,139,750.00 for local cost share including \$360,250.00 in contingency funds.
- 2. The Board further authorizes the Procurement Director to add the \$3,500,000.00 of District funds to Contract Number CT14*198.
- 3. The appropriate District officers and employees are hereby authorized and directed to perform all acts necessary and desirable to give the effects to this Resolution.
