#### COOPERATIVE PROCUREMENT AGREEMENT

#### 1. Parties, Background and Purpose.

- 1.1. <u>Parties</u>. This Contract is between Pima County, a political subdivision of the State of Arizona ("<u>County</u>"), and Immedia LLC ("<u>Contractor</u>").
- 1.2. <u>Authority</u>. Pima County is authorized by Pima County Code § 11.24.010 and A.R.S. § 41-2632 to enter into cooperative purchasing arrangements. Pima County has entered into such an agreement with State of Arizona.

#### 1.3. Contract.

- 1.3.1. State of Arizona entered into a contract (Contract No. ADSPO17-184595) for specified goods and services with Immedia LLC, an industry leader in professional audio visual and technology systems integration ("Contractor"), which is currently in effect (the "State of Arizona Contract"). The State of Arizona Contract is incorporated into this Contract by this reference.
- 1.3.2. Sections 1.11 and 3.13 of the State of Arizona Contract provides that another governmental entity with which State of Arizona has a cooperative purchasing agreement may, with Contractor's approval, purchase products and services at the same prices and under the same terms as in the State of Arizona Contract.
- 1.4. <u>Purpose</u>. The Pima County Office of Emergency Management requires the necessary equipment and supplies to maintain the Emergency Operations Center (EOC) and sustain a state of the art EOC capable of being open and operational 24/7, prepared and equipped to support incident commanders and mitigate emergencies that impact our community. This request allows the Pima County Office of Emergency Management to replace equipment coming end of life.

#### 2. Term.

- 2.1. <u>Original Term</u>. This Contract is effective for a one-year period commencing on September 17, 2019 (the "<u>Initial Term</u>"). "Term," when used in this Contract, means the Initial Term plus any exercised Extension Options.
- 2.2. Extension Options. County may renew this Contract for up to four (4) additional periods of up to 1 year each (each an "Extension Option").
- 3. Scope of Services. Contractor agrees to furnish Pima County the goods and/or services ("Goods & Services") which includes pricing, described in Exhibit A: Immedia LLC Scope of Work (48 Pages) to this Contract, under the terms and conditions of the State of Arizona Contract as modified by this Contract. The terms and conditions set forth in this Contract control over any inconsistent provisions in the State of Arizona Contract and any inconsistent provisions in Exhibit A. Scope allows for additional materials and services as required.
- 4. **Not-to-Exceed Amount**. Purchases under this Contract by the County may not exceed \$300,000.00.
- 5. Indemnification Clause. To the fullest extent permitted by law, Contractor will defend, indemnify, and hold harmless Pima County and any related taxing district, and the officials and employees of each of them (collectively, "Indemnitee") from and against any and all claims, actions, liabilities, losses, and expenses (including reasonable attorney fees) (collectively, "Claims") arising out of actual or alleged injury of any person (including death) or loss or damage to tangible or intangible property caused, or alleged to be caused, in whole or in part, by any act or omission of Contractor or any of Contractor's directors, officers, agents, employees, volunteers, or subcontractors. This indemnity includes any claim or amount arising or recovered under the Workers' Compensation Law or arising out of the failure of Contractor to conform to any federal, state or local law, statute, ordinance, rule, regulation or court decree. The Indemnitee will, in all instances, except for Claims arising solely from the acts or omissions of the Indemnitee, be indemnified by Contractor from and against any and all Claims. Contractor is responsible for primary loss investigation, defense and judgment costs for any Claim to which this indemnity applies. This indemnity will survive the expiration or termination of this Contract.
- 6. Insurance Requirements. The Insurance Requirements herein are minimum requirements for this Contract and in no way limit, the indemnity covenants contained in this Contract. Contractor's insurance shall be placed with companies licensed in the State of Arizona and the insureds shall have an "A.M. Best" rating of not less than A- VII. Pima County in no way warrants that the minimum insurer rating is sufficient to protect the Contractor from potential insurer insolvency.
  - 6.1. Minimum Scope and Limits of Insurance: Contractor shall procure and maintain, until all contractual obligations have been discharged, the insurance coverage with limits of liability not less than stated below. Pima County in no way warrants that the minimum insurance limits contained herein are sufficient to protect the Contractor from liabilities that arise out of the performance of the work under this Contract. If necessary, Contractor may obtain commercial umbrella or excess insurance to satisfy the County's Insurance Requirements.
    - Commercial General Liability (CGL) Occurrence Form with limits of \$2,000,000 Each
      Occurrence and \$2,000,000 General Aggregate. Policy shall include bodily injury,
      property damage, broad form contractual liability coverage, personal and advertising
      injury and products completed operations.

- <u>Business Automobile Liability</u> Bodily Injury and Property Damage for any owned, hired, and/or non-owned automobiles used in the performance of this Contract with a Combined Single Limit (CSL) of \$1,000,000 each accident.
- Workers' Compensation (WC) and Employers' Liability Statutory requirements and benefits for Workers' Compensation. In Arizona, WC coverage is compulsory for employers of one or more employees. Employer's Liability coverage- \$1,000,000 each accident and each person - disease.
- <u>Claim-Made Insurance Coverage</u> If any part of the Required Insurance is written on a claims-made basis, any policy retroactive date must precede the effective date of this Contract, and Contractor must maintain such coverage for a period of not less than three (3) years following Contract expiration, termination or cancellation.
- 6.2. <u>Additional Coverage Requirements</u>: The policies shall include, or be endorsed to include, as required by this written agreement, the following provisions:
  - Additional Insured: The General Liability and Business Automobile Liability Policies shall each be endorsed to include Pima County, its departments, districts, boards, commissions, officers, officials, agents, and employees as additional insureds with respect to liability arising out of the activities performed by or on behalf of the Contractor.
  - <u>Subrogation</u>: The General Liability, Business Automobile Liability and Workers'
    Compensation Policies shall each contain a waiver of subrogation endorsement in
    favor of Pima County, and its departments, districts, boards, commissions, officers,
    officials, agents, and employees for losses arising from work performed by or on behalf
    of the Contractor.
  - <u>Primary Insurance</u>: The Contractor's policies shall stipulate that the insurance afforded the Contractor shall be primary and that any insurance carried by Pima County, its agents, officials, or employees shall be excess and not contributory insurance.
  - Insurance provided by the Contractor shall not limit the Contractor's liability assumed under the indemnification provisions of this Contract.
- 6.3. Notice of Cancellation: Each Required Insurance policy must provide, and certificates specify, that County will receive not less than thirty (30) days advance written notice of any policy cancellation, except 10-days prior notice is sufficient when the cancellation is for non-payment of a premium. Notice shall include the Pima County project or contract number and project description.
- 6.4. <u>Verification of Coverage</u>: Contractor shall furnish Pima County with certificates of insurance as required by this Contract. An authorized representative of the insurer shall sign the certificates.
  - All certificates and endorsements, as required by this written agreement, are to be
    received and approved by Pima County before work commences. Each insurance
    policy required by this Contract must be in effect at, or prior to, commencement of work
    under this Contract. Failure to maintain the insurance coverages or policies as required
    by this Contract, or to provide evidence of renewal, is a material breach of contract.

- All certificates required by this Contract shall be sent directly to the appropriate County
  Department. The Certificate of Insurance shall include the Pima County project or
  contract number and project description on the certificate. Pima County reserves the
  right to require complete copies of all insurance policies required by this Contract at
  any time.
- 6.5. Approval and Modifications: The Pima County Risk Manager may approve a modification of the Insurance Requirements without the necessity of a formal Contract amendment, but the approval must be in writing. Neither the County's failure to obtain a required insurance certificate or endorsement, the County's failure to object to a non-complying insurance certificate or endorsement, or the County's receipt of any other information from the Contractor, its insurance broker(s) and/or insurer(s), constitutes a waiver of any of the Insurance Requirements.
- Cancellation for Conflict of Interest. This Contract is subject to cancellation for conflict of interest pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-511, the pertinent provisions of which are incorporated into this Contract by reference.
- 8. Compliance with Laws. Contractor will comply with all applicable federal, state, and local laws, rules, regulations, standards and Executive Orders. Contractor warrants that it is appropriately licensed to provide the services under this Contract and that any subcontractors will be appropriately licensed. The laws and regulations of the State of Arizona govern the rights and obligations of the parties under this Contract. Any action relating to this Contract must be filed and maintained in the appropriate court of the State of Arizona in Pima County.
- 9. Non-Discrimination. Contractor will comply with all provisions and requirements of Arizona Executive Order 2009-09, which is hereby incorporated into this Contract, including flow-down of all provisions and requirements to any subcontractors. During the performance of this Contract, Contractor will not discriminate against any employee, client or any other individual in any way because of that person's age, race, creed, color, religion, sex, disability or national origin.
- 10. Non-Appropriation of Funds. Notwithstanding any other provision in this Contract, County may terminate this Contract if for any reason there are not sufficient appropriated and available monies for the purpose of maintaining County or other public entity obligations under this Contract. In the event of such termination, County will have no further obligation to Contractor, other than to pay for services rendered prior to termination.
- 11. Public Information. Pursuant to A.R.S. § 39-121 et seq. all documents submitted to County by Contractor, including but not limited to pricing schedules, product specifications, work plans, and any supporting documents, are public records. As such, those documents are subject to release and/or review by the general public upon request, including competitors. If Contractor reasonably believes that some of those records contain proprietary, trade-secret or otherwise-confidential information, Contractor must prominently mark those records "CONFIDENTIAL." In the event a public-records request is submitted to County for records marked CONFIDENTIAL, County will notify Contractor of the request as soon as reasonably possible. County will release the records 10 business days after the date of that notice, unless Contractor has, within that period, secured an appropriate order from a court of competent jurisdiction, enjoining the release of the records. County will not, under any circumstances, be responsible for securing such an order, nor will County be in any way financially responsible for any costs associated with securing such an order.

#### 12. Requirements for Contracts Funded by Federal Grants.

- 12.1. <u>Remedies</u>. Either party may pursue any remedies provided by law for the breach of this Contract. No right or remedy is intended to be exclusive of any other right or remedy and each is cumulative and in addition to any other right or remedy existing at law or at equity or by virtue of this Contract.
- 12.2. <u>Termination without Cause</u>. County may terminate this Contract at any time, without cause, by serving a written notice upon Contractor at least 30 days before the effective date of the termination. In the event of such termination, County's only obligation to Contractor will be payment for services rendered prior to the date of termination.
- 12.3. <u>Termination with Cause</u>. County may terminate this Contract at any time without advance notice and without further obligation to County when County finds Contractor to be in default of any provision of this Contract.
- 12.4. Contractor may have to comply with awarding agency requirements and regulations pertaining to patent rights with respect to any discovery or invention which arises or is developed in the course of or under such contract (37 C.F.R. Part 401).
- 12.5. Contractor must comply with applicable standards, orders or requirements issued under:
  - 12.5.1. Clean Air Act (42 U.S.C. §§ 7401-7671q.)
  - 12.5.2. Federal Water Pollution Control Act (33 U.S.C. §§ 1251-1387) as amended (Contracts and subawards in excess of \$150,000)
- 12.6. <u>Debarment and Suspension</u> (Executive Orders 12549 and 12689). A contract award (see 2 C.F.R. § 180.220) must not be made to parties listed on the government wide exclusions in the System for Award Management (SAM), in accordance with the OMB guidelines at 2 C.F.R. Part 180 that implement Executive Orders 12549 (3 C.F.R. Part 1986 Comp., p. 189) and 12689 (3 C.F.R. Part 1989 Comp., p. 235), "Debarment and Suspension." SAM Exclusions contains the names of parties debarred, suspended, or otherwise excluded by agencies, as well as parties declared ineligible under statutory or regulatory authority other than Executive Order 12549.
- 12.7. Byrd Anti-Lobbying Amendment (31 U.S.C. § 1352). Contractors that apply or bid for an award exceeding \$100,000 must file the required certification. Each tier certifies to the tier above that it will not and has not used Federal appropriated funds to pay any person or organization for influencing or attempting to influence an officer or employee of the agency, a member of Congress, officer or employee of Congress, or an employee of a member of Congress in connection with obtaining any Federal contract, grant or any other award covered by 31 U.S.C. § 1352. Each tier must also disclose any lobbying with non-Federal funds that takes place in connection with obtaining any Federal award. Such disclosures are forwarded from tier to tier up to the non-Federal award.
- 12.8. Compliance with Section 6002 of Solid Waste Disposal Act, as amended by the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act. The requirements of Section 6002 include procuring only items designated in guidelines of the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) at 40 C.F.R. Part 247 that contain the highest percentage of recovered materials practicable, consistent with maintaining a satisfactory level of competition, where the

purchase price of the item exceeds \$10,000 or the value of the quantity acquired during the preceding fiscal year exceeded \$10,000; procuring solid waste management services in a manner that maximizes energy and resource recovery; and establishing an affirmative procurement program for procurement of recovered material identified in the EPA guidelines.

### 13. Legal Arizona Workers Act Compliance.

- 13.1. <u>Compliance with Immigration Laws</u>. Contractor hereby warrants that it will at all times during the term of this Contract comply with all federal immigration laws applicable to its employment of its employees, and with the requirements of A.R.S. § 23-214 (A) (together the "State and Federal Immigration Laws"). Contractor will further ensure that each subcontractor who performs any work for Contractor under this Contract likewise complies with the State and Federal Immigration Laws.
- 13.2. <u>Books & Records</u>. County has the right at any time to inspect the books and records of Contractor and any subcontractor in order to verify such party's compliance with the State and Federal Immigration Laws.
- 13.3. Remedies for Breach of Warranty. Any breach of Contractor's or any subcontractor's warranty of compliance with the State and Federal Immigration Laws, or of any other provision of this section, is a material breach of this Contract subjecting Contractor to penalties up to and including suspension or termination of this Contract. If the breach is by a subcontractor, and the subcontract is suspended or terminated as a result, Contractor will be required to take such steps as may be necessary to either self-perform the services that would have been provided under the subcontract or retain a replacement subcontractor, as soon as possible so as not to delay project completion. Any additional costs attributable directly or indirectly to such remedial action are the responsibility of Contractor.
- 13.4. <u>Subcontractors</u>. Contractor will advise each subcontractor of County's rights, and the subcontractor's obligations, under this Section 24 by including a provision in each subcontract substantially in the following form:

"Subcontractor hereby warrants that it will at all times during the term of this contract comply with all federal immigration laws applicable to Subcontractor's employees, and with the requirements of A.R.S. § 23-214 (A). Subcontractor further agrees that County may inspect the Subcontractor's books and records to insure that Subcontractor is in compliance with these requirements. Any breach of this paragraph by Subcontractor is a material breach of this contract subjecting Subcontractor to penalties up to and including suspension or termination of this contract." CONTRACTOR hereby warrants that it will at all times during the term of this Contract comply with all federal immigration laws applicable to CONTRACTOR's employment of its employees, and with the requirements of A.R.S. § 23-214 (A) (together the "State and Federal Immigration Laws"). CONTRACTOR will further ensure that each subcontractor who performs any work for CONTRACTOR under this contract likewise complies with the State and Federal Immigration Laws.

14. **Written Orders.** County will order products or services under this Contract by issuing a Delivery Order (DO) document. Order documents will be furnished to Contractor via e-mail or telephone.

If an order is given verbally, the County Department that issued the order will transmit a confirming order document to Contractor within five workdays of the date the verbal order is given.

Contractor must not supply materials or services pursuant to the contract that are not documented or authorized by a Delivery Order (DO) at the time of provision. County accepts no responsibility for control of or payment for materials or services not documented by a County Delivery Order (DO).

Contractor will establish, monitor, and manage an effective contract administration process that assures compliance with all requirements of this Contract. In particular, Contractor will not provide goods or services other than those described in this Contract, in excess of the NTE Amount, or after the Term of the Contract has ended, without a Contract amendment properly executed and issued by County, as provided below. Any items provided in excess of that stated in this Contract are at Contractor's own risk.

- 15. Amendments. The County may extend or revise this Contract by notifying Contractor in writing of the change, which notice will be in the form of a revised "Master Agreement." If Contractor does not object in writing to the proposed changes within ten (10) calendar days after receipt of the notice, Contractor will be deemed to have accepted the changes, and the revision will be binding on the parties, effective as of the date the notice was issued. If Contractor objects to one or more of the changes, then the proposed changes will be deemed to be ineffective.
- 16. Israel Boycott Certification. Pursuant to A.R.S. § 35-393.01, if Contractor engages in forprofit activity and has 10 or more employees, and if this Contract has a value of \$100,000.00 or more, Contractor certifies it is not currently engaged in, and agrees for the duration of this Contract to not engage in, a boycott of goods or services from Israel. This certification does not apply to a boycott prohibited by 50 U.S.C. § 4842 or a regulation issued pursuant to 50 U.S.C. § 4842.





#### 1. ACCEPTANCE OF TERMS

This quotation shall not be binding upon Immedia Integrated Technologies (IMMEDIA) until signed by the Buyer and accepted in writing by a duly authorized representative of IMMEDIA. Any modification, addition to, or waiver of any of the terms and conditions of this quotation shall not be effective unless in writing and signed by an authorized representative of IMMEDIA. Customer's signature on this document or receipt of the equipment shall constitute assent to all terms and conditions contained herein. Proposals are valid for 30 days following issue. Should you wish to reconsider a project at a later date, we will review and revise the proposal and timeline to reflect current conditions.

### 2. DELIVERY

Immedia will use its best efforts to deliver the Equipment in accordance with the Customer requested delivery date subject to receipt of all necessary information from the Customer. IMMEDIA reserves the right to substitute equipment of "like kind, quality and price" in the event a specified product has been discontinued by the manufacturer or is no longer available. Shipping dates are approximate only, and IMMEDIA shall not be liable for delays or for failure to manufacture due to causes beyond its reasonable control or due to compliance with any government regulations.

### 3. RUSH DELIVERY FEE

There is no rush delivery fee required for this project.

### 4. INSTALLATION

The location must be secure, structural work, ceiling grid, millwork, HVAC, high voltage electrical and conduit must be completed for this installation to be delivered on time. Delays due to incomplete work by sub-contractors may cause this installation to be postponed or rescheduled. Any required software will be provided by Immedia to the Customer prior to the first scheduled day of installation and must be installed by the Customer, or their designated IT company. IMMEDIA shall not be liable for failures of or delays in manufacture, delivery or installation resulting from any cause or causes beyond its reasonable control.

Outsourced installation labor may be subcontracted to complete the project, in cooperative effort with Immedia's Project Management and/or Installation resources.

### 5. SCHEDULE & ACCESSIBILITY

This proposal contains a fixed price for labor that has been estimated using historical data. This estimate is based upon the assumption that Immedia will have unfettered access to perform work in 8 hour increments. Additional labor charges may be incurred if IMMEDIA's installation staff is unable to perform work in continuous 8 hour increments with complete access to the location, whether due to client or general contractor conflicts. Title to the Equipment shall pass to Customer upon delivery and completed installation subject to a purchase money security interest retained by the Company in the Equipment sold and the proceeds thereof until payment of all amounts then due to the Company. IMMEDIA shall be entitled to remove the Equipment from the Customer's premises if all payments are not made when due. Customer agrees to execute financing statements under the Uniform Commercial Code or other documents as the Company requests to protect its security interest.

#### 8. NON-SOLICITATION

Immedia's employees cannot be hired by a Customer for a period of 180 days after the final project they performed work on, without prior approval from Immedia and/or without a 50% employee referral fee paid to Immedia by the Customer for that employee's W2 payments (for the last 12 months and/or extrapolation of their wages if they have not been an employee for over 1 year).

#### 9. WARRANTY

Unless an ImmediaCare agreement is purchased, Immedia's standard warranty is ninety (90) days.
