Contractor will provide work experience with employers offering jobs that may lead to career pathways; or English as a Second Language (ESL) in reading, writing, math and/or science to bolster a desire to return to school. The ESL program will improve prospects for future employability and self-sufficiency for youth participating in the program.

*Program Goals/Predicted Outcomes:

Contractor will serve up to 88 total youth in the Workforce Development Services Program.

58 youth in the Work Experience

Participants will successfully complete at least 95% of scheduled work hours.

Participant will increase work readiness and occupational skills as measured through pre- and post- testing and assessment of performance.

30 youth in the ESL Program

Participants in the ESL Program will average a grade level increase of at least one-half and attain at least 80% proficiency in work readiness skills.

The program will stress basic reading, writing, math, science and oral communication skills.

*Public Benefit:

The benefit of the program is it supports Pima County's economic development by helping to develop a trained and productive labor force that meets employers' needs.

Reports on the number of youth participating in the program, outcome of pre- and post-testing, and completion results.

AMENDMENT ONE

1. BACKGROUND AND PURPOSE.

- 1.1. <u>Background</u>. Pima County ("County") and SER—Jobs for Progress of Southern Arizona, Inc. ("Contractor"), entered into the above-referenced contract to provide workforce development services to Pima County youth.
- 1.2. <u>Purpose</u>. County operates a workforce development program at Pima County ARIZONA@WORK (an American Job Center, formerly the Pima County One Stop).
 - 1.2.1. County finds that it is in the best interests of the Pima County residents to continue to provide workforce development services to at-risk youth.
 - 1.2.2. County has reviewed Contractor's performance of the services and finds it satisfactory.
- 2. <u>TERM AND EXTENSIONS</u>, SECTION 1.0. Pursuant to paragraph 1.2, County exercises the first of two (2) available Extension Options. This Agreement will terminate on **December 31, 2020**.
- 3. **COMPENSATION AND PAYMENT**, **SECTION 3.0** is amended as follows:
 - 3.1. Paragraph 3.1 is amended to increase "the Maximum Allocated Amount":

TO: \$302,714.08

3.2. Paragraph 3.2 is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

3.3. Paragraph 3.3 is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

Unexpended funds allocated for a contract year will not be carried over into another contract year.

3.4. Paragraph 3.4, the first sentence is amended to read:

Using the form set forth in **EXHIBIT A of this Amendment No. 1**, Contractor must submit a Monthly Invoice Request itemizing the amount requested for each population served, <u>every</u> <u>month that participants are receiving services</u>, even if no funds are being requested for the prior month.

4. <u>ISRAEL BOYCOTT CERTIFICATION</u>, SECTION 31.0 is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

Pursuant to A.R.S. § 35-393.01, if Contractor engages in for-profit activity and has 10 or more employees, and if this Agreement has a value of \$100,000.00 or more, Contractor certifies it is not currently engaged in, and agrees for the duration of this Agreement to not engage in, a boycott of goods or services from Israel. This certification does not apply to a boycott prohibited by 50 U.S.C. § 4842 or a regulation issued pursuant to 50 U.S.C. § 4842.
