# \*Project Title/Description:

Ready, Set, School! program support for families in the Tucson as well as Green Valley and Sahuarita communities

### \*Purpose:

Funding will be designated to purchase specially designed School Readiness for 450 families identified through participation in the Library's Ready Set School! program at those libraries serving communities where both the child poverty rate and the number of children who are not enrolled in a quality preschool is high. Bilingual Spanish English Kits can help parents carry out their role as their child's first teacher, and as they build essential foundational skills in key areas of learning and development. Kits bundle up 80 school readiness activities: from letter recognition to phonetic awareness, to learning numbers; from focus and perspective taking to emotional intelligence.

### \*Procurement Method:

Not applicable to grant awards.

## \*Program Goals/Predicted Outcomes:

Four hundred and fifty families will have additional resources in their homes that will assist them as they build essential foundational skills so their young children are prepared to enter Kindergarten.

### \*Public Benefit:

Pima County families will benefit from additional in-home resources and quality programs that encourage families to build home libraries, read, sing, play, and pursue science and math activities that build executive functioning skills for their young children. In target areas of Pima County 85% children are not enrolled in a quality pre-school program, and more than half the children under the age of five are growing up in poverty.

### \*Metrics Available to Measure Performance:

Library will collect the following to share with UWTSA -- outcomes-based surveys; observational data; success stories, and plans for future implementation of sponsored Ready Set School activities.

### \*Retroactive:

Yes. Library received notification in September of the funding amount. Library has worked with Grants Management and Innovation on approval and to set up this award. If the funding is not approved Tucson as well as Green Valley and Sahuarita communities parents and their young children will not benefit from School Readiness Kits.
