WHEREAS, an estimated 94 percent of consumers overwhelmingly say they value the contributions that small businesses make to their communities; and

WHEREAS, Small Business Saturday, the Saturday after Thanksgiving, has proven to be a significant holiday-seasons shopping day for small businesses and a day in which they enjoy the patronage of many first-time customers; and
