### \*Purpose:

Amendment of Award: Master Agreement No. MA-PO-17-125, Amendment No. 05. This Amendment extends the termination date by three (3) years to 12/20/22 and adds a one-time increase of \$1,714,650.00 for a cumulative notto-exceed contract amount of \$2,883,650.00. This increase is required for additional costs related to the existing Enterprise Agreement and for additional ESRI products/services as needed.

### \*Procurement Method:

Pursuant to Pima County Procurement Code 11.12.050, Sole source procurement, on 12/16/16, the Procurement Director approved an award of contract for an initial term of three (3) years and a not-to-exceed award amount of \$240,000,00 for a cumulative not-to-exceed contract amount of \$720,000.00 with two (2) one-year renewal options.

On 01/10/17, the Procurement Director approved Amendment No. 01 which incorporated Insights User Term Licenses for AreGIS as Enterprise Software.

On 11/06/18, the Board of Supervisors approved Amendment No. 02 for a one-time increase of \$249,000.00 for a cumulative not-to-exceed contract amount of \$969,000.00, to support upgrading and adding new software to the existing GIS system and incorporated Advantage Program Agreement (EEAP).

On 01/18/19, the Procurement Director approved Amendment No. 03 which updated the Unit-Priced Items table found in Appendix B- Enterprise License Fee Schedule by decreasing the ESRI Enterprise Advantage Program subscription fee from \$86,860.00 to \$86,000.00.

On 05/07/19, the Board of Supervisors approved Amendment No. 04 for a one-time increase of \$200,000.00 for a cumulative not-to-exceed contract amount of \$1,169,000.00, to support upgrading and adding new software to the existing GIS system utilized by Pima County departments.

Original two (2) renewal options were never exercised from the original award. ESRI standard contract terms are for three (3) year periods with no renewal options. This Amendment has removed future annual awards, as the contract fully-incorporates the needs for the next three (3) years.

### CONTRACT AMENDMENT

The parties agree to amend the above-referenced contract as follows:

### 1. Background and Purpose.

- **1.1.** <u>Background</u>. On 12/21/16, County and Contractor entered into the above referenced ELA to provide ESRI Geographic Information Systems Software ELA.
- **1.2.** County requires additional funding to support upgrading and adding new software to the existing GIS system, which will be utilized by additional Pima County departments.
- **1.3.** The parties want to extend the contract due to the County's continued need for ESRI Geographic Information Systems Software ELA to assist with Web-Mapping and Charting.
- 2. **Maximum Payment Amount.** The maximum amount the County will spend under this ELA, as set forth in Section 2.A. Not to Exceed Contract Amount, Contract Term/Renewals, and Revisions, is increased by \$1,714,650.00. County's total payments to Contractor under this contract, including any sales taxes, will not exceed \$2,883,650.00.
- Scope of Products/Services. The parties have revised the scope to extend the period of performance, update pricing, described in Exhibit A: ESRI Schedules (4 pages), including additional Products/Services.
- 4. **Israel Boycott Certification.** Pursuant to A.R.S. § 35-393.01, if Contractor engages in forprofit activity and has 10 or more employees, and if this Contract has a value of \$100,000.00 or more, Contractor certifies it is not currently engaged in, and agrees for the duration of this Contract to not engage in, a boycott of goods or services from Israel. This certification does

not apply to a boycott prohibited by 50 U.S.C. § 4842 or a regulation issued pursuant to 50 U.S.C. § 4842

The effective date of this Amendment is December 21, 2019.

All other provisions of the ELA not specifically changed by this Amendment remain in effect and are binding upon the parties.
