Requested Board Meeting Date: January 21, 2020

Title: Camino De La Tierra No Parking

Introduction/Background:

The Pima County Department of Transportation received a citizen request to prohibit parking on Camino De La Tierra due to emergency vehicle access concerns. This portion of Camino De La Tierra is a narrow, non paved roadway.

Discussion:

To accommodate emergency vehicle access, a minimum roadway width of 20 feet is recommended. A portion of Camino De La Tierra is only 15 feet wide which would prohibit the passage of emergency vehicles should parking be allowed.

Conclusion:

To insure passage of emergency vehicles along a narrow portion of Camino De La Tierra, prohibition of parking is necessary.

Recommendation:

The Pima County Department of Transportation recommends a No Parking ordinance be approved for both sides of Camino De La Tierra from 900 feet north of Bilby Road to 1,300 feet north of Bilby Road. This provides staff the flexibility of posting No Parking signs where recommended. The ordinance comes in to effect when and to the extent that signs are posted on the roadway.

ORDINANCE	2020 -

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF PIMA COUNTY, ARIZONA, RELATING TO TRAFFIC AND HIGHWAYS; REGULATING PARKING ON CAMINO DE LA TIERRA IN PIMA COUNTY, ARIZONA

THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF PIMA COUNTY, ARIZONA FINDS THAT:

- 1. The Board of Supervisors of Pima County, Arizona has authority under A.R.S. § 28-627 and 28-873 as amended, to regulate the stopping, standing or parking of vehicles.
- 2. The Board of Supervisors has determined that it is in the interest of public safety to establish that vehicles should not park on portions of Camino De La Tierra.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF PIMA COUNTY, ARIZONA:

- SECTION 1. Parking on both sides of Camino De La Tierra from 900 feet north of Bilby Road to 1,300 feet north of Bilby Road shall be regulated as No Parking.
- SECTION 2. All other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are superseded to the **ext**ent of such conflicts.
- SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take into effect when and to the extent that signs are posted on the highway herein listed giving notice of the parking restriction.
- SECTION 4. Violators of this ordinance shall be subject to civil or criminal sanctions as provided by law.
- SECTION 5. The various county officers and employees are authorized and directed to perform all acts necessary or desirable to give effect to this ordinance.
