A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF PIMA COUNTY, ARIZONA; RELATING TO PLANNING; AMENDING THE PIMA COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE PLAN LAND USE MAP FROM MEDIUM INTENSITY URBAN (MIU) TO NEIGHBORHOOD ACTIVITY CENTER (NAC) FOR APPROXIMATELY 89 ACRES LOCATED ON THE WEST SIDE OF N. LA CANADA DRIVE, APPROXIMATELY 60 FEET NORTH OF THE TINTERSECTION OF N. LA CANADA DRIVE AND W. KIMBERLY STREET, IN SECTION 15 OF TOWNSHIP 13 SOUTH, RANGE 13 EAST (ADDRESSED 5131 N. LA CANADA DRIVE), IN THE CATALINA FOOTHILLS PLANNING AREA.

IT IS RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF PIMA COUNTY, ARIZONA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Pima County Comprehensive Plan Land Use Map in the Catalina Foothills Planning Area is hereby amended to change the planned land use intensity category for approximately .89 acres, as referenced in P19CR00001 Hesser LCP LLC - N. La Canada Drive Concurrent Plan Amendment and Rezoning, located on the west side of N. La Canada Drive, approximately 60 feet north of the T-intersection of N. La Canada Drive and W. Kimberly Street, in Section 15, Township 13 South, Range 13 East, as shown on the map attached to this Resolution as Exhibit A and incorporated by this reference, from Medium Intensity Urban (MIU) to Neighborhood Activity Center (NAC).

<u>Section 2.</u> The various County officers and employees are authorized and directed to perform all acts necessary to give effect to this Resolution.

<u>Section 3.</u> This Resolution shall become effective on the date of adoption.

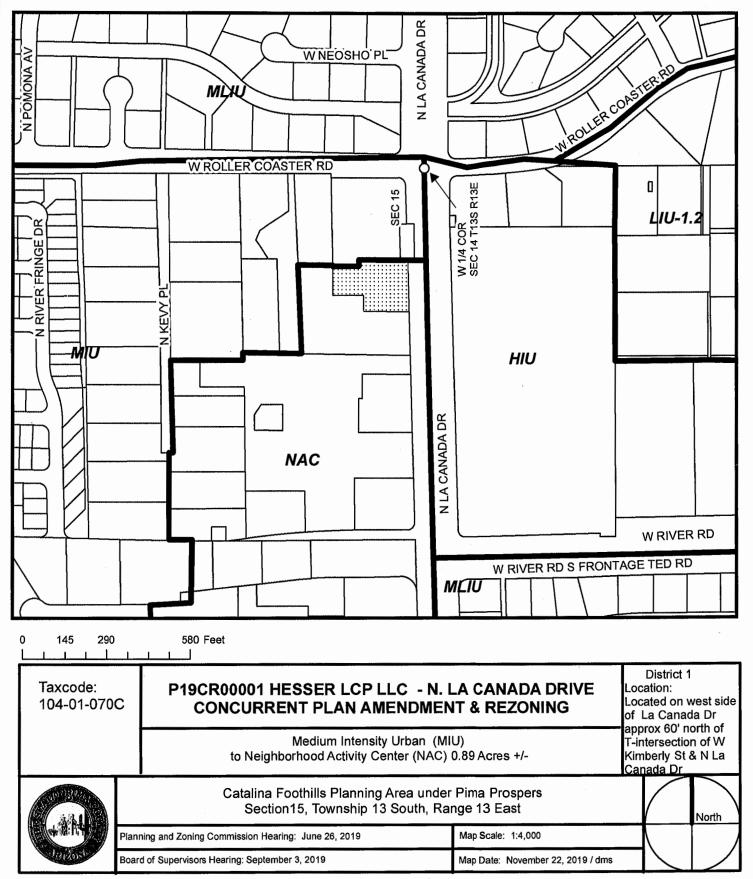

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF PIMA COUNTY, ARIZONA; RELATING TO ZONING; REZONING APPROXIMATELY .89 ACRES OF PROPERTY (ADDRESSED 5131 N. LA CANADA DRIVE) FROM SH (SUBURBAN HOMESTEAD) TO CB-2 (GENERAL BUSINESS) ZONE, IN CASE P19CR00001 HESSER LCP LLC – N. LA CANADA DRIVE CONCURRENT PLAN AMENDMENT AND REZONING, LOCATED ON THE WEST SIDE OF N. LA CANADA DRIVE, APPROXIMATELY 60 FEET NORTH OF THE TINTERSECTION OF N. LA CANADA DRIVE AND W. KIMBERLY STREET, AND AMENDING PIMA COUNTY ZONING MAP NO. 45.

#### IT IS ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF PIMA COUNTY, ARIZONA:

Section 1. The .89 acres located on the on the west side of N. La Canada Drive, approximately 60 feet north of the T-intersection of N. La Canada Drive and W. Kimberly Street and illustrated by the shaded area on the attached rezoning ordinance map (Exhibit A), which amends Pima County Zoning Map No. 45, is rezoned from the SH (Suburban Homestead) to the CB-2 (General Business) zone subject to the conditions in this ordinance.

#### Section 2. Rezoning conditions.

- 1. The property owner shall not further lot split or subdivide the land without the written approval of the Board of Supervisors.
- Environmental Planning conditions: Upon the effective date of the Ordinance, the owner(s) shall have a continuing responsibility to remove buffelgrass (Pennisetum ciliare) from the property. Acceptable methods of removal include chemical treatment, physical removal, or other known effective means of removal. This obligation also transfers to any future owners of property within the rezoning site and Pima County may enforce this rezoning condition against the property owner.
- 3. In the event that human remains, including human skeletal remains, cremations, and/or ceremonial objects and funerary objects are found during excavation or construction, ground disturbing activities must cease in the immediate vicinity of the discovery. State Laws ARS 41-865 and/or ARS 41-844 require that the Arizona State Museum be notified of the discovery at (520) 621-4795 so that appropriate arrangements can be made for the repatriation and reburial of the remains by cultural groups who claim cultural or religious affinity to them. The human remains will be removed from the site by a professional archaeologist pending consultation and review by the Arizona State Museum and the concerned cultural groups.
- 4. Adherence to the sketch plan (Exhibit B) as approved at public hearing.
- 5. Less restrictive rezoning applications may not be submitted under the approved comprehensive plan designation. A separate comprehensive plan amendment and rezoning are required for less restrictive zoning.
- 6. In the event the subject property is annexed, the property owner shall adhere to all applicable rezoning conditions, including, but not limited to, development conditions which

- require financial contributions to, or construction of infrastructure, including without limitation, transportation, flood control, or sewer facilities.
- 7. The property owner shall execute the following disclaimer regarding Proposition 207 rights: "Property Owner acknowledges that neither the rezoning of the Property nor the conditions of rezoning give Property Owner any rights, claims or causes of action under the Private Property Rights Protection Act (Arizona Revised Statutes Title 12, chapter 8, article 2.1). To the extent that the rezoning or conditions of rezoning may be construed to give Property Owner any rights or claims under the Private Property Rights Protection Act, Property Owner hereby waives any and all such rights and/or claims pursuant to A.R.S. § 12-1134(I)."

Section 3. Time limits of conditions. Conditions 1 through 7 of Section 2 shall be completed no later than September 3, 2024.

Section 4. The rezoning conditions of Section 2 may be amended or waived by resolution of the Board of Supervisors in accordance with Chapter 18.91 of the Pima County Zoning Code.

Section 5. The effective date of this Ordinance is the date the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors signs this Ordinance.

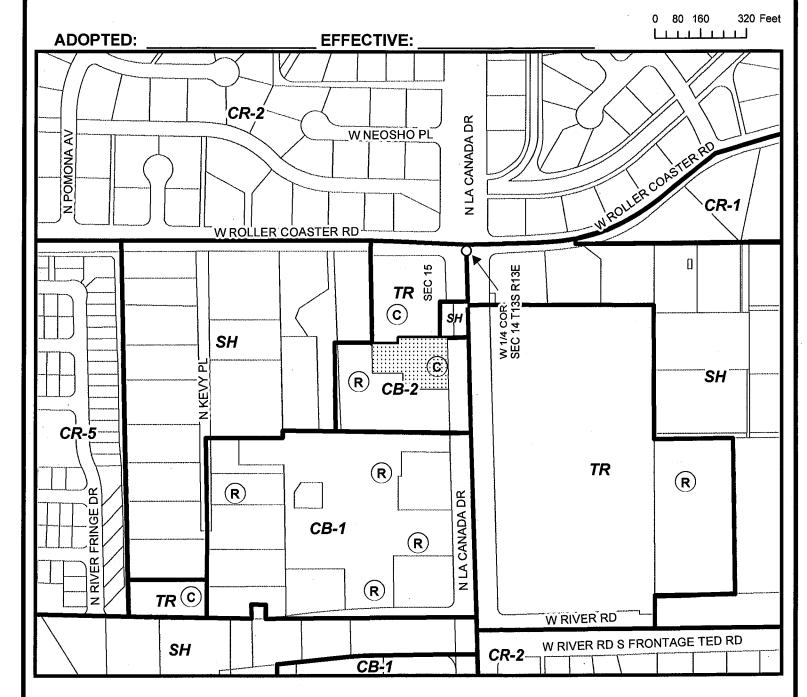
