Requested Board Meeting Date: February 18, 2020

Title: Co12-72-82 RESUBDIVISION OF LAS PALOMAS SUBDIVISION (LOT 297) PLAT NOTE WAIVER

Introduction/Background:

The applicant requests a plat note waiver on Lot 297 which states, "Recreation Area (Private)", in order to allow construction of a residence on the lot.

Discussion:

Lot 297 was designated as a private recreational area on the subdivision plat and there is no rezoning condition or code requirement for a recreation area. A variance was approved to allow access to the site from a platted alley connecting to W. Tucker Street and limited the number of residences to one.

Conclusion:

The residential use of Lot 297 is reasonable given the recreation area was never built, nor required by code,	rezoning _,

PLAT NOTE WAIVER

Co12-72-82 LAS PALOMAS RESUBDIVISION (Lot #297) PLAT NOTE WAIVER

Request of Robert Foytack for a waiver of the plat note on Lot 297 of Las Palomas Resubdivision (Bk. 24, Pg. 77) which states, "Recreation Area (Private)". The applicant requests to allow the use for a single family residence on the lot. The subject property is approximately 1.97 acres, zoned CR-3 (Single Residence) and is located 300 feet west of S. Cardinal Avenue and approximately 150 feet north of W. Tucker Street and is addressed as 3054 W. Tucker Street. Staff recommends APPROVAL SUBJECT TO STANDARD AND SPECIAL CONDITIONS.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends **APPROVAL** of the waiver of the plate note on Lot 297 to allow single-family residential use of the lot, subject to the following conditions:

- 1. One single family residence shall be developed on the property.
- 2. Access shall only occur through the alley way from W. Tucker Street.
- 3. Wastewater Management Conditions:
 - A. The owner(s) shall not construe any action by Pima County as a commitment to provide sewer service to any new development within the subject property until Pima County executes an agreement with the owner(s) to that effect.
 - B. The owner(s) shall obtain written documentation from the Pima County Regional Wastewater Reclamation Department (PCRWRD) that treatment and conveyance capacity is available for any new development within the proposed project site, no more than 90 days before submitting any tentative plat, development plan, preliminary sewer layout, sewer improvement plan, or request for building permit for review. Should treatment and/or conveyance capacity not be available at that time, the owner(s) shall enter into a written agreement addressing the option of funding, designing and constructing the necessary improvements to Pima County's public sewerage system at his or her sole expense or cooperatively with other affected parties. All such improvements shall be designed and constructed as directed by the PCRWRD.

C. The owner(s) shall time all new development within the subject property to coincide with the availability of treatment and conveyance capacity in the downstream public sewerage system.

- D. The owner(s) shall connect all development within the subject property to Pima County's public sewer system at the location and in the manner specified by the PCRWRD in its capacity response letter and as specified by PCRWRD at the time of review of the tentative plat, development plan, preliminary sewer layout, sewer construction plan, or request for building permit.
- E. The owner(s) shall fund, design and construct all off-site and on-site sewers necessary to serve the subject property, in the manner specified at the time of review of the tentative plat, development plan, preliminary sewer layout, sewer construction plan, or request for building permit.
- F. The owner(s) shall complete the construction of all necessary public and/or private sewerage facilities as required by all applicable agreements with Pima County, and all applicable regulations, including the Clean Water Act and those promulgated by ADEQ, before treatment and conveyance capacity in the downstream public sewerage system will be permanently committed for any new development within the subject property.

Conditions 1 and 2 are consistent with the variance granted by the Board of Adjustment (Case # P19VA00022) to allow the use of a platted alley as primary access to a lot, which is otherwise prohibited by Code.

Conditions 3.A-F pertain to Regional Wastewater Reclamation Department requirements for permitting the use of a sewer line.

REQUEST OF APPLICANT

The applicant requests a waiver of the plat note on Lot 297 of Las Palomas Resubdivision (Bk. 24, Pg. 77) which states "Recreation Area (Private)". The applicant cites a recorded deed (Docket 4467, Page 823) Las Palomas Resubdivision – Declaration of Building and Use Restrictions (private covenants) that Lots 1-208 inclusive, and Lots 283-321 inclusive are described as "...residential building lots".

PLANNING REPORT

Staff has no objection to granting waiver of the plat note for use of Lot 297 subject to a residence rather than a recreation area because there is no rezoning condition or other code requirement for a recreation area within the subdivision. It appears that Lot 297 was a surplus area that does not abut a street. A recreation area was never developed on the lot which has remained vacant for 47 years. Also, staffs review of the recorded private covenants for the subdivision affecting Lot 297 found no restriction against allowing the use for a single-family residence. In fact, the covenants includes Lot 297 as a residential building lot.

Additionally, the Board of Adjustment has approved a variance to allow access to Lot 297 from an unpaved alley rather than directly from a paved street. The alley connects to W. Tucker Street, a paved residential street located within Cardinal Estates Subdivision, located adjacent to and south of subject property. This approval was an essential step that allowed this plat note waiver request to go forward. The variance was conditioned upon access to the alley only from W. Tucker Street and upon a limit of one residence on the 1.97 acre lot. Limiting access to W. Tucker Street provides the shortest distance to a paved subdivision street, and the limit of one residence allows a reasonable use of the lot, but reduces the potential number of trips within the unpaved alley. At one unit per 8,000 square feet in the CR-3 zone, potentially ten units would otherwise be permitted.

The comprehensive plan designation for the subject lot is Medium Low Intensity Urban (MLIU) within the Southwest Planning Area. The comprehensive plan supports the CR-3 zoning designation. The area of the subdivision was rezoned to CR-3 in 1972. Las Palomas Resubdivision Lots 1-208 and 283-323 was recorded in 1973. The proposed site plan for the subject lot meets development standards for the CR-3 zone.

A 120 foot easement for El Paso Natural Gas Company runs along many lots within the subdivision including north of Lot 297 which restricts access to the north.

Public notice of the plat note waiver request is being sent to property owners within, and within 300 feet of the Las Palomas Resubdivision. No Public comment has been received as of the writing of this report. The applicant should be aware that a property owner within the subdivision may privately enforce the plat note, even if the Board of Supervisors grants the waiver request.

TRANSPORTATION REPORT

The Pima County Department of Transportation has no additional comments other than the conditions provided within the approved variance.

FLOOD CONTROL REPORT

The Pima County Regional Flood Control District has reviewed the request and has no objection.

WASTEWATER RECLAMATION REPORT

The Pima County Regional Wastewater Reclamation Department (PCRWRD) has reviewed the request and states that there is an existing 8" public sewer line with manhole near the northwest corner of the subject property. The property is likely to connect to this sewer line subject to PCRWRD's review and approval. PCRWRD has no objection to the request for a waiver of plat note, subject to conditions 3.A-F above.

Staff has not received a response to a request for comments.

Staff has not received a response to a request for comments.

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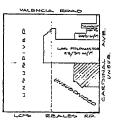

DECLARATION OF BUILDING & USE RESTRICTIONS

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That the undersigned, being the owner of all the property and premises situated in Pima County, Arizona, described as follows:

> Lots 1 thru 208 inclusive, and Lots 283 thru 321 inclusive, Las Palomas Resubdivision, a subdivision of Pima County, Arizona, according to the official map or plat thereof recorded in the office of the Pima County Recorder, in Book 24 of Maps and Plats, at page 77 thereof.

does hereby establish the following restrictions upon the use and enjoyment of the lots in said subdivision.

- Said lots shall be known and described as "residential building lots" and used for those purposes only.
- No structure shall be erected, altered, placed or permitted to remain on any of said lots other than one detached single family dwelling, not to exceed two stories in height, and private garage and storage room, one story in height. All construction of homes shall be of the type and kind of construction similar to other types of homes presently being constructed in the Southwest.
- 3. No residence building shall be erected, permitted or maintained on any of said lots, which shall have a ground floor area of less than 900 square feet, such ground floor area to be exclusive of open porches, pergolas, or an attached garage.
- 4. No building or the covered porches or pergolus thereof shall be erected, placed or permitted at any point on any of said lots nearer than 20 feet from the street front line of said lots; except as to the curved portions of front lines of any lots, the buildings may be placed or permitted up to and not nearer than 10 feet from the nearest point of said curved portions. This particularly applies to all corner lots and all lots surrounding a cul-de-sac.
- No building or the covered porches or pergoles thereof shall be erected, placed or permitted at any point on any of said lots, nearer than 5 feet to the side lines thereof; provided, however, that this restriction shall not apply to fences, garages, or carports, situated on the side property line at a point parallel with the rear of the house or extended back of this point.
- 6. Minimum distance from main building to rear lot line shall not be less than 15 feet.
- 7. No residential building site shall be used for business, nor any activities conducted of an offensive nature, nor any activities conducted creating a noxious odor; except developer may use any number of lots necessary for construction yard, sample houses and offices while engaged in the construction and sale of houses in this subdivision.

- 8. No temporary house, trailer, garage, tent or other buildings can be placed, or erected upon any part of this subdivision and occupied as living quarters. However, during the construction of a house on any lot any necessary temporary buildings may be erected and maintained by the person constructing the house. No person shall occupy or live in any house until it is completed, painted ready for occupancy.
- No shrubs, trees, or obstructions of any kind shall be placed on corner lots in such places as to cause a traffic hazard.
- 10. No cattle, hogs, sheep, goats, horses, rabbits, poultry or other livestock shall be kept or maintained upon any lot. This paragraph shall not be construed, however, as prohibiting or in any way interfering with the keeping or ordinary domest pet animals upon said property.
- 11. No vehicle of any type which is abnadoned or inoperable shall be stored or kept on any lot within this subdivision in such a manner as to be seen from any other lot or from any streets or alleyways within this subdivision.
- 12. The owner or owners of lots or portions of lots in said subdivision shall be responsible for the proper maintenance and repair of the exterior portions of dwellings constructed on said lot or portions so as said dwelling shall not become in disrepair to the extent that same would be highly objectionable and constitute a nuisance.

These covenants and restrictions are made for the benefit of the lots herein described, and are to run with the land and shall inure to the benefit of and be binding on all parties or persons claiming under them until January 1, 1995, at which time such covenants and restrictions shall be suctomatically extended for successive periods of five years; provided, however, that at any time the owners of 51% or more of the lots in said subdivision by their instrument in writing and duly recorded amend or change these restrictions and conditions.

If any person, their heirs or assigns, shall violate or attempt to violate any of the covenants herein, it shall be lawful for any other person or persons, owning any real property situated in said development or subdivision to prosecute any proceedings at law or in equity against the person or persons violating or attempting to violate any such covenant and either to prevent him or them from so doing or to recover damages or other dues for such violation. Provided, that any violation of the foregoing provisions, conditions, restrictions, or covenants shall not defeat or render invalid the lien of any mortgage or deed of trust made in good faith for value as to any portion of said property. But such provisions, conditions, restrictions, or covenants shall be enforceable against any portion of said property acquired by any person through foreclosure or by deed in lieu of foreclosure for any violation of the provisions, conditions, restrictions and covenants herein contained occurring after the acquisitions of said property through foreclosure or deed in lieu of foreclosure.

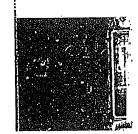

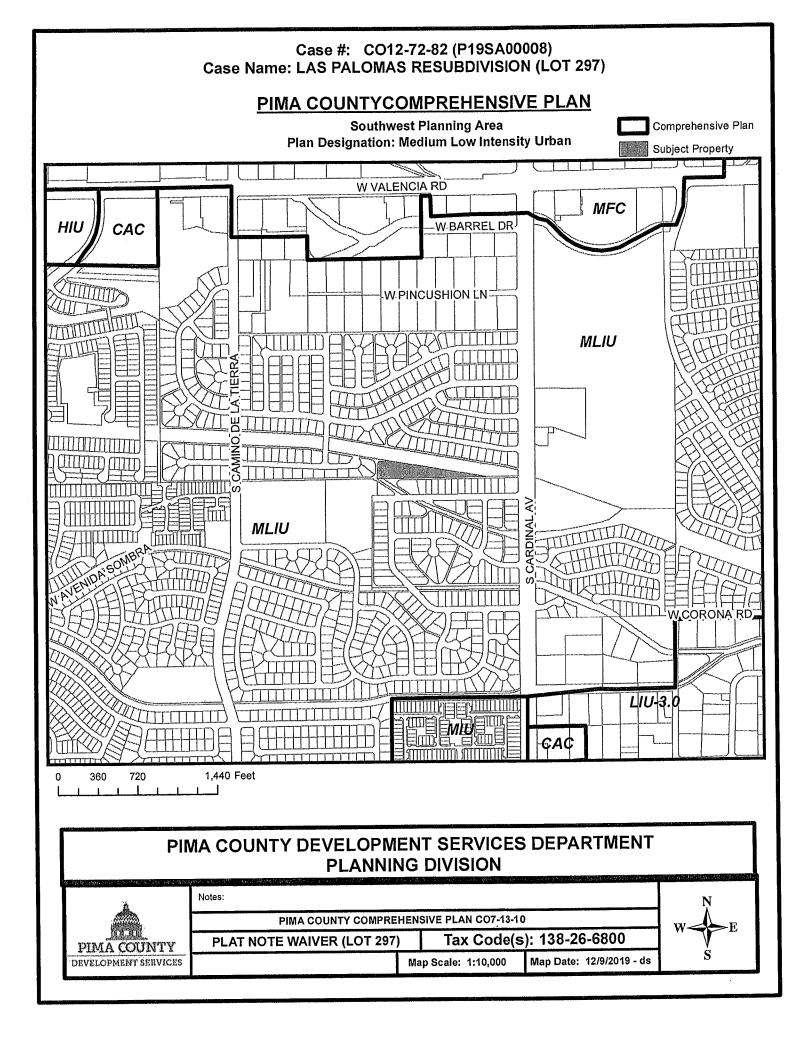


Land Use Legend and Map

The Pima County Board of Adjustment, District 5, at a regular hearing held on Thursday, November 14, 2019, heard the following appeals and decided as noted:

HEARINGS

P19VA00020 FLORES - WEST NEBRASKA STREET.

Daniel Flores on property located at **2261 West Nebraska Street** in the CR-4 zone, request the following **variance**:

1. To keep allotted livestock on the above address. Section 18,27.010 of the Pima County Zoning Code does not provide for the keeping up to two horses in the CR-4 zone.

The Board APPROVED the variance request subject to the following conditions:

- 1. This variance approval is subject to continued review based upon the absence of complaints relating to the equine activities.
- 2. Horses shall be limited to two (2).
- 3. Hay and feed storage shall be limited to that associated with up to two (2) horses.
- 4. No on-site sale of feed
- 5. No noise, light, glare, or odor impacts shall occur in conjunction with the keeping of horses.

P19VA00022 FOYTACK - WEST TUCKER STREET.

Robert Foytack at property located at **3054 West Tucker Street** in the CR-3 zone, request the following **variance**:

1. Use a platted alley as primary access to a lot. Section 18.69.040E of the Pima County Zoning Code states that alleys shown on an approved plat shall not be used as primary access to lots.

The Board APPROVED the variance request subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Only one single family unit shall be developed on the property.
- 2. Access shall only occur from West Tucker Street.

An application for necessary permits for use of the property and construction shall be made within nine months of the granting of a variance and within thirty days of the issuance of a temporary use permit. Failure to apply for necessary permits within the time limit shall render the variance or temporary use permit null and void.

in support of his petition. It was thereupon moved by Mr. weaver, second - Jay, and carried that the rezoning from SR to CR-1 be approved subject to the Commission's recommendations and that the necessary ordinance be drawn for presentation to the Board upon compliance with the requirements.

DP&Z-Z: Co9-72-74, PIONEER NATIONAL TRUST COMPANY (T-10232) PETITION

The Chairman stated that this is the time and the place designated and legally advertised for hearing on the petition (Co9-72-74) of Pioneer National Trust Company (T-10232) to rezone from GR to CR-3 property (approximately 107 acres) on the west side of Cardinal Avenue south of Valencia Road, within the Saginaw Hill Area Plan (Co13-70-3). The Planning Director reported that the petition is in order and that the Planning and Zoning Commission unanimously recommends that the petition be approved subject to:

"(1) Submittal of a drainage report;

- (2) Recording an acceptable plat that will provide for necessary rights of way for roads and drainage;
- (3) Recording a covenant holding Pima County harmless in the event of flooding;
- (4) Completion of the requirements for a zoning ordinance within three (3) years from the date of approval by the Board of Supervisors; and,
- (5) A suitable arrangement with the Pima County Department of Sanitation regarding sanitary facilities."

He added that the Commission had received several protests, eight of which were from within less restrictive zones than CR-3. The property had previously been approved for TH zoning, in which 21.7 units per acre are permissible; and since only 3.4 units can be built in CR-3 zones, the dense development the protestants feared will not take place. In reply to a question from Mr. Jay, the Planning Director stated the property is outside the radius of the Historic Zone designated for the San Xavier Mission.

The Chairman inquired whether anyone wished to be heard. Ray Elias, engineer representing the petitioners, stated he was present to answer any questions which might arise. No one else appeared. It was thereupon moved by Mr. Weaver, seconded by Mr. Jay, and carried that the rezoning from CR to CR-3 be approved subject to the Commission's recommendations and that the necessary ordinance be drawn for presentation to the Board upon compliance with the requirements.
