PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, February 2020 has been designated Career and Technical Education Month by the Association for Career and Technical Education; and

WHEREAS, career and technical education offers students the opportunity to gain the academic, technical and employability skills necessary for true career readiness; and

WHEREAS, students in career and technical education programs in Pima County gain these employability skills through the Pima County Joint Technical Education District in partnership with 14 local school districts; and

WHEREAS, career and technical education provides students with career exploration opportunities earlier in their educational experience, which in Pima County has led to a laudable 98% graduation rate for students who complete a JTED/CTE program; and

WHEREAS, career and technical education prepares students, including more than 200,000 through JTED, for these and other fulfilling careers by offering integrated programs of study that link secondary and postsecondary education with industry-recognized credentials; and

WHEREAS, career and technical education programs ensure that employers have access to a qualified and thriving workforce, that – in Pima County – contributes \$34 million annually to our local economy and helps ensure America has a strong and competitive economy.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Pima County Board of Supervisors hereby proclaims the month of February 2020 to be:
