RELATING TO BOARDS, COMMISSIONS, AND COMMITTEES; APPOINTING A TOWN OF MARANA CITIZEN REPRESENTATIVE TO THE TUCSON-PIMA COUNTY BICYCLE ADVISORY COMMITTEE
