AMENDMENT THREE

1. BACKGROUND AND PURPOSE

- 1.1. Background. On August 17, 2017, Pima County (“County”), a body politic and corporate of the State of Arizona and Monster Worldwide, Inc. *dba* Monster Government Solutions, L.L.C. (“Contractor”), a foreign corporation doing business in the State of Arizona, entered into the above-referenced Contract for the provision of online aptitude and interest assessments.
- 1.2. Purpose. County operates a workforce development program at Pima County ARIZONA@WORK (an American Job Center, formerly the Pima County One Stop).
 - 1.2.1. County finds that it is in the best interests of the Pima County residents to continue to provide workforce development services for adults, dislocated workers, and youth.
 - 1.2.2. County has reviewed Awardee’s performance of the services and finds it satisfactory.

2. **TERM, EXTENSIONS AND AMENDMENTS, SECTION 2.0.** Pursuant to Paragraph 2.2, the County exercises the third of four (4) extension options. This Contract will terminate on **June 30, 2021**.
3. **SCOPE OF SERVICES, SECTION 3.0.** Contractor will provide the goods and services identified in Section 3.0 for the new contract year.
4. **KEY PERSONNEL, SECTION 4.0** is amended to change the key personnel for Account Manager:
FROM: Rheannan Pramuk
TO: Bob Braman
5. **ISRAEL BOYCOTT CERTIFICATION, SECTION 28.0** is added to read:
Pursuant to A.R.S. § 35-393.01, if Awardee engages in for-profit activity and has 10 or more employees, and if this Agreement has a value of \$100,000.00 or more, Awardee certifies it is not currently engaged in, and agrees for the duration of this Agreement to not engage in, a boycott of goods or services from Israel. This certification does not apply to a boycott prohibited by 50 U.S.C. § 4842 or a regulation issued pursuant to 50 U.S.C. § 4842.

All other provisions of the Contract not expressly modified in this Amendment will remain in effect and be binding on the parties.






