*Purpose:

Amendment of Award: Master Agreement No. MA-PO-16-266, Amendment No. 3. This Amendment is for a one-time increase in the amount of \$28,122.49 for a cumulative not-to-exceed contract amount of \$1,703,601.49 and revises the scope of services for the third project. Administering Department: Information Technology.

*Procurement Method:

Pursuant to Pima County Procurement Code 11.24.010, Cooperative Procurement Authorized, on 04/05/16, the Board of Supervisors approved an award of contract for a term of six (6) years and a contract award amount of \$1,570,209.00.

On 06/07/16, the Board of Supervisors approved Amendment No. 1, which was a one-time increase in the amount of \$81,070.00 for a cumulative not-to-exceed amount of \$1,651,279.00 to cover the additional aerial photography images of the Alter Valley Watershed to develop a watershed restoration plan.

On 04/03/18, the Board of Supervisors approved Amendment No. 2, which was a one-time increase in the amount of \$24,200.00 for a cumulative not-to-exceed contract amount of \$1,675,479.00 to cover additional 79sq. miles of high resolution aerial photography images of several locations for Public Works, County Assessor's Office, and Economic Development Departments.

Before each two-year imagery capture, the areas of interest are re-evaluated to be sure the needs of the departments are met. The outcome of this evaluation can either increase or decrease the area that needs to be captured. In this year's evaluation by the departments, it was determined that an increase for an additional 32 sq. miles of new and increased resolution imagery is needed to support the needs of Natural Resources, Parks and Recreation department.


