**Title:** Westover Avenue No Parking

### Introduction/Background:

The Pima County Department of Transportation received a citizen request to restrict parking on Westover Avenue south of Alvaro Road. The citizen stated that there are people selling goods in this area outside the Tohono O'odham Swap Meet.

### Discussion:

Pima County Department of Transportation staff conducted a review of the area. There is an existing No Parking ordinance for Westover Avenue from Alvaro Road north to Drexel Road. No Parking signs are posted in this area as a result. According to the requestor, vendors are now parking south of Alvaro Road in the dirt area on the westside of Drexel Road.

### Conclusion:

The no parking limits on Westover Avenue are recommended to be extended further south from Alvaro Road to Valencia Road as result of the citizen request and field review. An ordinance for this entire segment of Westover Avenue provides staff the flexibility of posting No Stopping, Standing or Parking signs where recommended based on reported and observed parking concerns.

### Recommendation:

The Pima County Department of Transportation recommends an ordinance designating Westover Avenue from Drexel Road to Valencia Road as No Stopping, Standing or Parking be approved and ordinance 1987-58 section 1a be repealed.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF PIMA COUNTY, ARIZONA, RELATING TO TRAFFIC AND HIGHWAYS; REGULATING PARKING ON WESTOVER AVE IN PIMA COUNTY, ARIZONA

### THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF PIMA COUNTY, ARIZONA FINDS THAT:

- 1. The Board of Supervisors of Pima County, Arizona has authority under A.R.S. §§ 28-627 and 28-873 as amended, to regulate the stopping, standing or parking of vehicles.
- 2. The Board of Supervisors has determined that it is in the interest of public safety to establish that vehicles should not stop, stand or park on portions of Westover Avenue.

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF PIMA COUNTY, ARIZONA:

- SECTION 1. That parking on both sides of Westover Avenue from Drexel Road to Valencia Road be regulated as No Stopping, Standing or Parking.
- SECTION 2. Ordinance 1987-58 Section 1a and all other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are superseded to the extent of such conflicts.
- SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect when and to the extent that signs are posted on the highway herein listed giving notice of the parking restriction.
- SECTION 4. Violators of this ordinance are subject to civil or criminal sanctions as provided by law.
- SECTION 5. The various county officers and employees are authorized and directed to perform all acts necessary or desirable to give effect to this ordinance.
