I strongly encourage you to pass this resolution. According to The Migration Policy Institute, there are 198,000 unauthorized immigrants in Arizona who do not qualify for relief under the CARA Act. Of those, 91,000 are children; 43,000 are spouses many of whom are U.S. citizens. Those who filed their tax return with a IT number and who paid taxes, are disqualified.

Many of these ineligible live in Pima County. They are unable to pay their rent, buy groceries, pay for gas. Many continue to work in unsafe conditions due to the virus.

Please support all of Pima County residents with this much needed aid.
