Title: Town of Oro Valley's Annexation of Calle Concordia between La Canada Dr and Calle Loma Linda

Introduction/Background:

Seeking Approval by the Board of Supervisors in the acceptance of the Resolution and Order which approves the Annexation of Calle Concordia by the Town of Oro Valley under Resolution and Order No. (R) 20-22.

Discussion:

On May 20, 2020, the Mayor and Council of the Town of Oro Valley passed and adopted the Annexation under Resolution and Order No. (R)20-22 which included a segment of Calle Concordia Road between La Canada Dr and Calle Loma Linda, which falls within unincorporated Pima County, Arizona.

This Annexation will provide the Town with full control of the maintenance and operation of the segment of Calle Concordia between La Canada Dr and Calle Loma Linda.

A provision of ARS 9-471(N) allows that "... a county right-of-way or roadway may be transferred to an adjacent city or town by mutual consent of the governing bodies of the county and city or town if the property transferred is adjacent to the receiving city or town and if the city or town and county each approve the proposed transfer as a published agenda item at a regular public meeting of their governing bodies. A transfer of property made pursuant to this subsection shall be treated by the receiving city or town as if the transferred property was newly annexed territory."

The recent adoption of Resolution and Order No.(R)20-22 by the Town's Mayor and Council, approving the Calle Concordia right-of-way annexation, would take effect 30 days after the approval by Pima County Board of Supervisors. The resolution being submitted would give that approval.

Conclusion:

If Approved:

The segment of Calle Concordia road right-of-way between La Canada Dr and Calle Loma Linda will be annexed by the Town of Oro Valley.

If Denied:

The segment of Calle Concordia road right-of-way between La Canada Dr and Calle Loma Linda will remain within Pima County's jurisdiction.

Recommendation:

The Department of Transportation recommends approval of the Town of Oro Valley's Annexation of Calle Concordia road right-of-way.

Fiscal Impact:

No future funding for the maintenance of this segment of Calle Concordia would be required.

A RESOLUTION AND ORDER OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF PIMA COUNTY, ARIZONA, CONSENTING TO ANNEXATION OF A SEGMENT OF CALLE CONCORDIA BY THE TOWN OF ORO VALLEY, ARIZONA, A PORTION OF CALLE CONCORDIA, AS DEDICATED IN ROAD ESTABLISHMENT PROCEEDING NO. 1822, AND AS DEPICTED IN BOOK 14 OF ROAD MAPS ON PAGE 56, LOCATED WITHIN SECTION 23, TOWNSHIP 12 SOUTH, RANGE 13 EAST, GILA AND SALT RIVER MERIDIAN, PIMA COUNTY, ARIZONA.

The Pima County Board of Supervisors finds:

- 1. A.R.S. § 9-471(N) authorizes the transfer of county right-of-way or roadway by mutual consent of the governing bodies of the county and the adjacent city or town, and provides that a transfer of property made pursuant to the statue shall be treated by the receiving city or town as if the transferred property was newly annexed territory;
- 2. The Town of Oro Valley, Arizona, wishes to annex the segment of Calle Concordia pursuant to A.R.S. § 9-471(N), a legal description of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A;
- 3. The Town Council of Oro Valley approved the annexation of Calle Concordia at its regular public meeting held on May 20, 2020, under Town Resolution and Order No.(R)20-22, and
- 4. The Pima County Board of Supervisors has determined it to be in the best interests of Pima County to approve the Town's annexation of Calle Concordia.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that:

- 1. The annexation of Calle Concordia, as described in the attached Exhibit A, by the Town of Oro Valley is hereby approved.
- 2. In conformance with A.R.S. § 9-471(D) and (N), said annexation shall be effective thirty days after the adoption of this Resolution.

3. The appropriate County officers and employees are hereby authorized and directed to perform all acts necessary and desirable to give effect to this Resolution.
