PIMA COUNTY RESOLUTION FOR THE ADOPTION OF THE BUDGET FISCAL YEAR 2020/2021

The Board of Supervisors of Pima County, Arizona finds:

- 1. On May 19, 2020, in accordance with A.R.S. § 42-17101 et seq., the Board of Supervisors made an estimate of the different amounts required to meet the public expenditures of the County for the ensuing year, an estimate of revenue from sources other than direct taxation, and the amount to be raised by taxation upon real and personal property of Pima County.
- 2. The estimates were published as required by law, together with a notice that the Board would hold a public hearing and special board meeting on this date for the purpose of hearing taxpayers.
- The public hearing was duly held today, at the time and place designated in the published notice, at which any taxpayer was privileged to appear and be heard in favor of or against any of the proposed expenditures or tax levies.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the estimates of revenues and expenditures shown on the accompanying schedules are adopted as the budget of Pima County for the Fiscal Year 2020/2021.
