**PIMA COUNTY RESOLUTION FOR THE ADOPTION OF THE
FLOOD CONTROL DISTRICT BUDGET
FISCAL YEAR 2020/2021**

The Board of Supervisors, sitting as the Board of Directors of the Pima County Flood Control District (the "District"), finds:

1. On May 19, 2020, in accordance with A.R.S. §§ 42-17101 et seq., 48-252, and 48-3620, the Board of Supervisors, sitting as the District Board, made an estimate of the different amounts required to meet the public expenditures of the District for the ensuing year, an estimate of revenue from sources other than direct taxation, and the amount to be raised by taxation upon real property of the District.
2. The estimates were published as required by law, together with a notice that the Board would hold a public hearing and special board meeting on this date for the purpose of hearing taxpayers.
3. The public hearing was duly held today, at the time and place designated in the published notice, at which any taxpayer was privileged to appear and be heard in favor of or against any of the proposed expenditures or tax levies.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the estimates of revenues and expenditures shown on the accompanying schedules are adopted as the budget of District for the Fiscal Year 2020/2021.
