SECOND AMENDMENT EXTENDING INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN PIMA COUNTY AND THE CITY OF TUCSON FOR STREET NAMING AND ADDRESSING SERVICES

This Intergovernmental Agreement Amendment is entered into by and between Pima County, a body politic and corporate of the State of Arizona ("County") and City of Tucson ("Tucson") pursuant to A.R.S. § 11-952.

Recitals

- A. On July 6, 2010, the County and Tucson entered into an Intergovernmental Agreement ("IGA") to establish the authority for the creation of addresses to property and improvements within the jurisdictional boundaries of the City.
- B. On July 7, 2015, the County and Tucson agreed to extend the IGA an additional five years.
- C. The term of the first amendment to the IGA is five years and expires on July 7, 2020.
- D. The County and Tucson desire to extend the IGA for an additional five years, with further renewals upon the written agreement of the parties.

Agreement

Therefore, the County and Tucson mutually agree as follows:

- 1. The IGA is extended for an additional five years, effective July 7, 2020 and terminating **July 7, 2025**, unless, prior to the expiration of the period, extended or terminated by agreement of the parties.
- 2. Paragraph 7c is hereby amended to state "County shall perform all activities necessary to update and maintain addresses in the County's GIS mapping."
- 3. Paragraph 10 is hereby amended to state "County shall obtain recorded maps and plats electronically from the Pima County Recorder's office."
- 4. Paragraph 12 is hereby amended to state "City shall verify and use assigned addresses as shown in the County's GIS mapping in approving City plats, development plans and other land use regulations and in issuing City permits. Those individuals not having an assigned address will be sent to County for assignment."
- 5. All other terms and provisions of the IGA shall continue in full force and effect.

In witness whereof, the County has caused this Intergovernmental Agreement Amendment to be executed by the Chairman of its Board of Supervisors and attested to by the Clerk of the Board, and City has caused this Intergovernmental Agreement Amendment to be executed by the Mayor upon resolution of the Mayor and Council and attested to by:
