

P20RZ00004 - E. Vista Monte Drive Rezoning

Protest Calculations for June 9, 2020 Board of Supervisors' Hearing

Written protests pertaining to the above-reference rezoning <u>does</u> require a super-majority vote by the Board of Supervisors to approve the rezoning. To date, staff has received 66 written comments (letters/petitions) from 56 separate parcels in opposition to the request. Opposition with signatures from property owners constitutes 60.53% by number of owners and 80.91% by area of ownership within 300 feet of the rezoning site, which is more than the 20% minimum protest required for the respective categories to require a super-majority vote by the Board of Supervisors to approve the rezoning. Concerns cited in the protest letter and petition are increased traffic, traffic safety in proximity to the school, and opposition to three-story buildings.




P20RZ00004 AZ BAPTIST CONVENTION - E VISTA MONTE DRIVE REZONING

Protest Calcs within 300

Protest by area: 80.91% or 13.10 acres (3.23 of 16.19 acres required for super majority)

Protest by Owners: 60.53% or 23 owners (8 of 38 owners required for super majority)

300' Acreage = 16.19
