A RESOLUTION OF THE PIMA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS CONDEMNING LAW ENFORCEMENT'S USE OF RUBBER BULLETS IN PIMA COUNTY BECAUSE THEY INJURE INNOCENT PEOPLE'S EYES

WHEREAS, the deaths at the hands of law-enforcement of George Floyd, Breonna Taylor, Eric Garner and others sparked a series of peaceful protests across the country this summer, and in several cases officers fired rubber bullets to disperse protesters, causing eye injuries and blindness, and

WHEREAS, while rubber bullets are designed to be non-lethal, they can cause life-altering injuries, especially to the eyes, and even blindness, when law-enforcement officers fire them, and

WHEREAS, after numerous serious injuries across the country that rubber bullets caused during dispersing of peaceful protests, the American Academy of Ophthalmology called on domestic law enforcement agencies to immediately end the use of rubber bullets, and

WHEREAS, the Academy calls for physicians, public health officials, and the general public to condemn the use of rubber bullets, and

WHEREAS, all people in the United States have the right to speak and protest in public gatherings about issues that are important to them without fear of law enforcement actions that could seriously injure them or even cost them their vision, and

WHEREAS, the Pima County Board of Health is advisory to the Pima County Board of Supervisors and it recommends that the Supervisors act to protect the health of county citizens by condemning the use of all types of rubber bullets in all cases of law enforcement activities in Pima County,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Pima County Board of Supervisors hereby condemns law enforcement's use of rubber bullets for any purpose in Pima County,
