Requested Board Meeting Date: April 7, 2020

Title: An Ordinance Adopting a Fee Schedule for Licensing, Shelter, Veterinary Care, and Related Services under Title 6 of the Pima County Code

Introduction/Background:

As part of the redraft of the Pima County Animal Code proposed in a separate ordinance, this ordinance would consolidate fees currently listed in Pima County Code, Chapters 6.04.060 - Shelter and veterinary care fees and 6.04.070 - Dog vaccinating, licensing, and permitting procedure and fees within county limits, in a single fee schedule.

Discussion:

Staff proposes establishing a fee schedule to replace the various listings of fees within the Pima Animal Code. Consolidating all animal service fees in a single schedule will make the information more accessible to the public and enable fees to be amended by a non-code ordinance. Fees have been adjusted to reflect the actual costs incurred by the animal services department, and additional services that the department routinely provideshave been added.

Pursuant to A.R.S. §§ 11-251.13 and 11-251.08, notice of the proposed ordinance was posted on the Pima County website on February 5 and is scheduled to be advertised in the Daily Territorial on March 23.

ORDINANCE 2020-	

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF PIMA COUNTY, ARIZONA, RELATING TO ANIMALS; TO ADOPT A FEE SCHEDULE FOR LICENSING, SHELTER, VETERINARY CARE, AND RELATED SERVICES PROVIDED BY THE ANIMAL SERVICES DEPARTMENT UNDER TITLE 6

OF THE PIMA COUNTY CODE

THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF PIMA COUNTY, ARIZONA, FINDS THAT:

- 1. The Board of Supervisors has authority under A.R.S. §§ 11-251.05, 11-1005(C), 11-1008, and 11-1009 to establish fees for animal licensing and permitting, and for sheltering and caring for animals by the animal services department.
- 2. The Board of Supervisors has determined that it is necessary to adopt a new fee schedule to set license and permit fees, and to set service fees to defray the department's reasonable costs including administrative costs.

IT IS ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF PIMA COUNTY, ARIZONA:

SECTION 1: Fees for animal licenses and permits and for sheltering and veterinary care and related services provided by the animal services department under Title 6 of the Pima County Code are hereby established as shown on the schedule attached to this Ordinance as Exhibit A and incorporated by this reference.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance is effective 30 days after the date of adoption.
