URGENT

I am responding to letters on the Internet from the Pima County Attorney and the Chief Civil Deputy County Attorney.

They wrongly claim that Pima Co. cannot include livestock in its animal-protection laws.

Pima County's current animal-protection laws do include livestock and these laws were approved, before being passed, by the very same County Attorney who is now attacking them.

In addition, A.R.S. 13-2910F grants very broad legislative power to counties, including the right to legislate protection for livestock. The County Attorney is now ignoring A.R.S. 13-2910F.

The Ag. Dept. of Agriculture refuses to help suffering livestock.
