**A RESOLUTION OF THE PIMA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS IN SUPPORT OF  
A NATIONAL WEEK OF MOURNING HONORING COVID-19 VICTIMS**

WHEREAS, more than one million people have died from the coronavirus worldwide; and

WHEREAS, more than 200,000 Arizonans have been stricken by COVID-19, resulting in more than 5,600 deaths; and
