Project Narrative. Describe how you plan to use the SGIA allotment. State Grants-In-Aid funding for Pima County Public Library (PCPL) will support learning opportunities and the exchange of ideas so that PCPL can reach goals related to priorities in its Community Impact Plan. Funds will focus on capacity building, and help keep the Library strong for the future. Employees and partners will focus on building a strong and diverse network of advocates through learning and networking in the fields of social justice, cultural understanding, and the breaking down of biases. For 20-21, PCPL is prioritizing team building, learning and development opportunities, and community-based inquiry with under-served populations.

Staff members will join others – community organizers, academics, students, artists, government employees, and community benefit workers – who are committed to racial equity and racial justice at the Facing Race National Conference. All workshop tracks are relevant to PCPL's vision: Narrative and Culture, Institutional and Sectoral Change, Movement and Community-Driven Solutions, and Race Identities and Innovations. This participation will ensure PCPL can move forward with its essential role in the cultivation of social awareness, social justice, social equity, and inclusion. In addition, more staff members will receive training in facilitating focused

discussions. The library has experience offering public programs with trained moderators leading small circles of dialogue. These community forums are designed to encourage honest and open communication. They bring community members together to express their concerns and hopes, and to learn new ways to be more involved and more active.

PCPL will extend the lessons learned from these community conversations to energize new modes of operation and outreach, particularly to marginalized communities. Our Community Impact Plan invites everyone to come and connect with us in a space where all dimensions of diversity are valued. Key messages in the plan include encouraging reflection and growth, creating intentional communities of practice, and sharing the responsibility to cultivate learning. The library mission aims to transform lives through responsive service and connection, in order to reflect the needs, opportunities, and identities of our diverse community. PCPL constantly strives to be the best for the community, and promises to amaze with all offerings. As Pima County Public Library carries out its Community Impact Plan, State-Grants-In-Aid funding will help staff at all levels of service learn to align their work for success, encourage collaboration with co-workers, and address organization health, even in times of uncertainty.
