Dear Chairman Valencia:

This letter is in support of a request of Pima Animal Care Center (PACC) for Pascua Yaqui Tribe 12-percent Revenue Sharing grant funds. If funded, the award will help support PACC in its efforts to provide quality animal care and lifesaving throughout Pima County.

Pima Animal Care Center's mission is to provide care, support and resources to the animals in Pima County, including companion animals of Pascua Yaqui members. Initiatives that have fulfilled this mission include: foster care, adoption, community resources, animal protection, and medical care. PACC has supported almost 19,000 animals this year in Pima County, finding homes for almost all of these animals, and generally providing resources to help pet owners keep their pets at home.

If the Pascua Yaqui Tribe names Pima Animal Care Center as an award recipient, Pima County will commit to pass-through the grant award to PACC for the purpose for which it was awarded. The Pima County Board of Supervisors approved a formal resolution committing Pima County to act as fiscal agent for PACC, on May 19, 2020.
