BYLAWS OF THE
TUCSON WALDORF EDUCATION ASSOCIATION, INC.

PREAMBLE

The Tucson Waldorf Education Association, Inc. (the TWEA) is organized to transact any and all lawful business for which nonprofit corporations may be incorporated under the laws of the State of Arizona, as they may be amended from time to time. The TWEA is organized for the promotion, encouragement and development, both financially and philosophically, of Waldorf Education in Tucson. This may include the establishment of a School or Schools and other facilities, scholarships and educational programs based on the philosophy and methods of Waldorf Education.

The TWEA welcomes people of any race, color, national and ethnic origin to all the rights, privileges, programs and activities generally afforded or made available through the TWEA. The TWEA does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national or ethnic origin in its admission, policies, financial assistance or in any of its programs.

ARTICLE I. GENERAL PROVISIONS

- 1) **Membership.** Members of the TWEA shall include all parents of students enrolled in the School or Schools established by the TWEA and such friends and supporters of Waldorf Education, familiar with the works of Rudolf Steiner or interested in Waldorf Education, as indicate their desire to become Members and contribute funds, other property or services to the TWEA. Membership in the TWEA shall be granted without discrimination and all Members shall hold equal rights and responsibilities.
- 2) **Rights and Responsibilities.**
 - a) All members have the right to participate in all activities and programs of the TWEA.
 - b) All members have the right to be informed of the activities, programs and business of the TWEA.
 - c) Members may use the TWEA Library.
 - d) Members have the responsibility to strive to act and speak so as to further and not hinder the philosophy of Waldorf Education and the goals of the TWEA.
 - e) Members have the responsibility to respect and abide by the Bylaws, Rules, Regulations, Policies and Procedures of the TWEA.
 - f) Members have the responsibility to strive to be aware of the influence of their actions and speech on the life of the community of which they are a part and to strive to conduct themselves to the benefit of this community.
- 3) **General Meeting.** The General Meeting of the TWEA shall be held each year in the month of May at a time and place fixed by the Board of Trustees.
- 4) **Organs of the TWEA.** The affairs of the TWEA shall be conducted by a College of Teachers, a Board of Trustees and a Parent-Teacher Organization. Each of these Organs serves a different purpose

and is proper to a different realm of affairs. The Organs shall strive to work together in harmony for the furtherance of the goals of the TWEA.

ARTICLE II. BOARD OF TRUSTEES

- 1) Purpose. The Board of Trustees (the Board) shall be established to provide for the material needs of Waldorf Education in Tucson. Its business shall include but shall not be limited to ownership and maintenance of facilities, establishment of scholarships, entrance into contracts and development and management of funds and securities on behalf of the TWEA.
- 2) Powers. The powers of the Board shall include but not be limited to the following:
 - a) To order and oversee the management of all property of the TWEA.
 - b) To make policy regarding the management and disbursement of all funds and securities of the TWEA.
 - c) To establish such rules, policies and procedures for the conduct of its own meetings as it finds convenient and proper.
 - d) To establish rules for the conduct of its members and dismiss Trustees for violation of these rules.
 - e) To establish offices, enumerate their duties and fix salaries and wages.
 - f) To enter into legally binding contracts on behalf of the TWEA. In the case of contracts of employment of pedagogical and administrative personnel the Board shall act to hire only upon prior recommendation of the College of Teachers.
 - g) To fix the amount of fees and tuition for enrollment in the School.
- 3) Trustees. The Board shall be composed of Officers and Representatives. The Officers shall consist of a President, Vice-President, Historian, Secretary and Treasurer. Representatives shall be selected by the College of Teachers and Parent-Teacher Organization as set forth in Article II, Section 7. Trustees should have an interest in Waldorf Education and should express both a compatibility with its principles and a willingness to grow in awareness of its underlying philosophy.
- 4) Conflict of Interest. Not more than forty-nine percent (49%) of the Trustees may be interested persons. An interested person is (i) any person compensated by the corporation for services rendered to it during the previous twelve (12) months, whether as a full or part-time employee, independent contract or otherwise; or (ii) any brother, sister, ancestor, descendant, spouse, brother-in-law, sister-in-law, son-in-law, daughter-in-law, mother-in-law or father-in-law of such a person.
 On any issue before the Board Trustees with a conflict of interest shall recuse themselves from hearing and participating in discussion and decision. Failure to do so shall constitute cause for removal from office. However, any violation of the provisions of this paragraph shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any transaction entered into by the TWEA.
- 5) Duties of Officers.

- a) **President.** The President shall preside at all meetings of the Board. He or she shall be an ex officio member of all Standing Committees of the Board. He or she shall from time to time make reports on the affairs of the Association to the Board.
 - b) **Vice-President.** The Vice-President shall perform the duties of the President in the absence or disability of the latter. In addition, the Vice-President shall perform such other duties as may be assigned to him or her by the Board.
 - c) **Historian.** The Historian shall serve to preserve the memory of the deeds and proceedings of the TWEA and shall when called upon recount the actions of the Board within their historical context.
 - d) **Secretary.** The Secretary shall attend the meetings of the Board and keep minutes thereof in suitable books. The Secretary shall perform all the usual duties incident the office of Secretary.
 - e) **Treasurer.** The Treasurer shall have care and custody of all the funds and securities of the TWEA and shall deposit same in a bank or banks or with such depository and depositories.
- 6) **Selection of Officers.** The Officers of the Board shall be elected by the Board of Trustees. Officers shall serve renewable terms of one year or until their successors are qualified and elected. Any Vacancy which occurs in an Office due to death, resignation, removal, disqualification, or otherwise shall be filled for the remainder of the unexpired term by the Board of Trustees in accordance with its regular procedure.
 - 7) **Selection of Representatives.** Prior to the end of the regular school term the College of Teachers and Parent-Teacher Organization in separate meetings shall elect their Representatives to the Board of Trustees. There shall be two Faculty Representatives and two Parent Representatives. Representatives shall serve renewable one-year terms as Trustees of the TWEA. Any Vacancy which occurs in a Faculty or Parent Representative position shall be filled for the remainder of the unexpired term by the College of Teachers or Parent-Teacher Organization respectively.
 - 8) **Advisory Board.** The Board of Trustees may, as it deems fitting and proper, appoint such Advisors as will aid it in the execution of its duties.
 - 9) **Removal of Trustees.** A Trustee may be removed from office for cause by a vote of the Board. Due cause for removal shall consist only of negligence, nonattendance, malfeasance, dereliction of duty, willful or repeated failure to abide by the Bylaws and Policies of the TWEA or Decisions of the Board or other gross ethical transgressions. Nonattendance at more than two consecutive regular Board meetings shall constitute grounds for removal.
The decision on a motion to remove a Trustee shall not be taken at the same meeting at which the motion was originally made. A majority of two-thirds shall be sufficient for the removal of a Trustee, but no Trustee shall vote in the matter of his or her own removal.
 - 10) **Meetings.** The Board shall meet regularly to conduct its business. Additionally, from time to time the President may convene the Board for a special purpose. A quorum for the conduct of business shall consist of a majority of the Trustees.
 - 11) **Board Decisions.** The Board of Trustees shall strive for consensus in its decisions. When the President of the Board determines that consensus cannot be reached, the issue will be tabled until

the next Board meeting for further discussion. At that time a vote of two-thirds of the Trustees present in person or by proxy will be sufficient for its approval.

ARTICLE III. COLLEGE OF TEACHERS

- 1) Purpose. The College of Teachers (the College) shall be established to nurture and guide the pedagogical and cultural work of the TWEA. Its business shall include the whole of the pedagogical affairs of the School including, but not limited to the governance of the School, its personnel and students, and the creation and execution of educational and cultural programs of the TWEA.
- 2) Membership. Membership in the College of Teachers shall be granted by act of the College. The College may make such rules and arrangements as it finds convenient to the conduct of its business. The College shall elect one of its number to serve in the capacity of Chair. The College shall make such rules governing the conduct of its members as it finds appropriate and shall make provisions for the dismissal of Members for the violation of those rules.
- 3) Powers. The College is empowered to make all decisions of a pedagogical nature regarding the School in accordance with the principles, procedures and practices of Rudolf Steiner's philosophy of education. These include but are not limited to the power to:
 - a) Make policy regarding the hiring, conduct and firing of School employees and volunteers holding positions of trust, including Teachers, Assistant Teachers and administrative personnel.
 - b) Make policy regarding the admission, conduct and expulsion of students.
 - c) Exclusively make recommendations to the Board regarding the hiring of Teachers, Assistant Teachers and administrative personnel and regarding the duties attendant on such offices.
 - d) Make policy regarding the eligibility for and award of such scholarships and tuition assistance as may be created and funded by the Board of Trustees. This power shall not be construed to limited in any way the exclusive power of the Board to allocate monies for scholarships and tuition assistance and set general policy for the disbursement and collection of funds.
 - e) Order and oversee the administration of the School and other cultural or educational programs of the TWEA.

ARTICLE IV. PARENT-TEACHER ORGANIZATION

- 1) Purpose. The Parent-Teacher Organization of the TWEA is created with a twofold purpose. It shall act to coordinate the parent body in serving the material and economic needs of the School in concert with the Board of Trustees and the College of Teachers. Additionally, it shall serve as a forum for social, cultural and educational activities benefiting the parent body. It shall not act to create policy or make decisions regarding the pedagogical or financial affairs of the School or the TWEA.

- 2) Membership. All parents of children attending the School and all Teachers Employed by the School shall be Members of the Parent-Teacher Organization.
- 3) Organization. The Parent-Teacher Organization shall meet regularly. It shall select its own Chair and such other officers as it deems convenient. It may make rules for the conduct of its meetings and affairs and exact dues to defray its expenses.

ARTICLE V. MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS

- 1) Amendment. These bylaws may be altered, amended or replaced by consensus of the Board of Trustees and College of Teachers.
- 2) Fiscal Year. The fiscal year shall terminate on the thirtieth of June of each year.
- 3) Establishment of College of Teachers. Until such time as a College of Teachers shall be established for the purposes of these bylaws its functions shall be performed and authority exercised by the Core Faculty or its nominees. The Core Faculty shall consist of those Teachers initially so designated by the Board of Trustees. The College of Teachers shall be established in due time by repeal of this clause by consensus of the Core Faculty and Board of Trustees as provided in Article V, Section 1.
- 4) Initial Selection of Parent Representatives. Until such time as the Parent-Teacher Organization has become established and has selected its Representatives to the Board the Board shall appoint the Parent Representatives.
