Requested Board Meeting Date: November 10, 2020

Title: Traffic Regulation - Reno Avenue and Wabash Street

Introduction/Background:

The Pima County Department of Transportation received a citizen request to install stop signs or yield signs at the four-legged intersection of Reno Avenue at Wabash Street. Reno Avenue and Wabash Street are both local roadways with a speed limit of 25 mph.

Discussion:

The Pima County Department of Transportation conducted a traffic control study at the Reno Avenue and Wabash Street intersection as a result of the citizen request. No sight visibility limitations were observed at the intersection and no crashes were reported in the past five years from 2015-2019.

Conclusion:

The traffic control study determined that yield signs are recommended to be installed for northbound and southbound Reno Avenue at Wabash Street to establish right-of-way at the four-legged intersection.

Recommendation:

The Pima County Department of Transportation recommends an ordinance be approved to designate Reno Avenue and Wabash Street as a yield intersection with traffic on Reno Avenue yielding to traffic on Wabash Street.

ORDINANCE 2020 - _____

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF PIMA COUNTY, ARIZONA, RELATING TO TRAFFIC AND HIGHWAYS; REGULATING TRAFFIC AT THE INTERSECTION OF RENO AVENUE AND WABASH STREET IN PIMA COUNTY, ARIZONA

THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF PIMA COUNTY, ARIZONA FINDS THAT:

1. The Board of Supervisors of Pima County, Arizona has authority under A.R.S. §§ 28-627 and 28-855 as amended, to designate and establish yield intersections and to erect yield signs.
2. The Board of Supervisors has determined that it is in the interest of public safety to establish the intersection of Reno Avenue and Wabash Street as a yield intersection in Pima County, Arizona.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF PIMA COUNTY, ARIZONA:

SECTION 1. The intersection of Reno Avenue and Wabash Street shall be designated a yield intersection with traffic on Reno Avenue yielding to traffic on Wabash Street.

SECTION 2. All other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are superseded to the extent of such conflicts.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect when and to the extent that yield signs are posted on the intersecting streets.

SECTION 4. Violators of this ordinance shall be subject to civil or criminal sanctions as provided by law.

SECTION 5. The various county officers and employees are authorized and directed to perform all acts necessary or desirable to give effect to this ordinance.
