#### \*Project Title/Description:

Immunization Services

#### \*Purpose:

Develop and support ongoing strategies to address immunization issues and promote activities to increase the immunization rates of Pima County's children, teens, and adults.

Amendment #3 adds \$125,000 to increase data entry and cold storage capacity, in anticipation of distribution of a COVID-19 vaccine to the community. This funding is to be spent by 06/30/2021. However, there is no change in the term of the grant, which continues until 12/31/2022.

#### \*Procurement Method:

This Intergovernmental Agreement is a non-Procurement grant and not subject to Procurement rules.

#### \*Program Goals/Predicted Outcomes:

- 1. Increase data entry capacity to support COVID-19 vaccine distribution documentation and reporting.
- 2. Increase mobile cold storage capacity to support COVID-19 vaccine distribution.
- 3. Increase static cold storage capacity to allow for greater storage capacity.
- 4. Increase capacity for reminder recall activities associated with COVID vaccine administration.

#### \*Public Benefit:

Vaccination will be a vital strategy to control the spread of COVID-19. This funding will enhance readiness for COVID-19 vaccine distribution in Pima County.

#### \*Metrics Available to Measure Performance:

- 1. Cubic feet of mobile/static cold storage
- 2. Acquisition of additional software for increased data entry and reminder activities.

#### IMMUNIZATION SERVICES

It is mutually agreed that the Intergovernmental Agreement referenced is amended as follows:

- 1. Pursuant to Terms and Conditions, Page Seven (7), Provision Six (6), Contract Changes; the Intergovernmental Agreement is amended to revise the following:
  - 1.1 Scope of Work, Page Nineteen (19), Provision 4.12, VPD Outbreak and Pandemic Preparedness, added items 4.12.3 and 4.12.4 that are hereby revised in this Amendment Three (3) to read:
    - 4.12.3 Improve vaccine cold storage capacity, to include purchase of storage units (refrigerator, freezer [NOT ultra-cold freezer]), generators, portable refrigeration units. These efforts are intended to help keep vaccines viable during the COVID-19 pandemic.
    - 4.12.4 Increase capacity for data entry and reminder recall activities, to include but not limited to additional staffing, or purchase of hardware and software equipment to accomplish this task. These efforts are intended to help track immunization data during the COVID-19 pandemic.
