*Metrics Available to Measure Performance:

Emergency Services Network database is used to report the number of households served.

*Retroactive:

Yes. Due to the implementation was de-prioritized while we focused on the overwhelming demand for assistance from COVID impacted households and there were adequate resources to meet non-COVID related demand until now. The program is set up to allow funds to be deposited, but will not be activated until Board of Supervisors' approval of the grant. The negative impact of not approving this amendment is low-income Pima County residents would not receive rent and mortgage assistance.
