*Program Goals/Predicted Outcomes:

To prevent eviction and foreclosure in Pima County. Rental/mortgage assistance: 164 households to be served.

*Public Benefit:

Funding will help alleviate poverty, prevent homelessness, and prevent disruption in the well-being of individuals, children and families as a whole while promoting self-sufficiency to Pima County residents.

*Metrics Available to Measure Performance:

Emergency Services Network database is used to report the number of households served.

*Retroactive:

Yes. Due to the implementation was de-prioritized behind the AZ Department of Housing Fund and COVID-19 Relief Fund dollars because both grants had to be fully expended by December 31, 2020. Community & Workforce Development is now ready to begin the implementation of the FEMA Phase CARES funds as the other sources will soon have been exhausted. The program is set up to allow funds to be deposited, but will not be activated until Board of Supervisors' approval of the grant. The negative impact of not approving this amendment is low-income Pima County residents would not receive rent and mortgage assistance.
