Title: Certification of School District Elections

Introduction/Background:

The Pima County School Superintendent is requesting that the Pima County Board of Supervisors accept the certified School District Election results.

Discussion:

The Superintendent of Schools has received the official canvas from the Pima County Elections Department for the Continental Elementary School District No. 39 Override, Marana Unified School District No. 6 Override, and Tanque Verde Unified School District No. 13 Bond special elections held on November 3, 2020.

The Pima County School Superintendent is responsible for conducting all school district special elections pursuant to A.R.S. § 15-302(A)(8) as the elections will not become certified until the Superintendent of Schools declares the results to the Pima County Board of Supervisors, pursuant to A.R.S. §§ 15-481(0), 15-426(B) and 15-493, and that the Board of Supervisors accept the results pursuant to A.R.S. §§ 15-426 and 15-492.

Conclusion:

The Pima County Superintendent of Schools will present the School District special election results to the Board of Supervisors, which will then certify the results.
