Title: Parking Regulation - Portions of Public Highways in the High Plains Ranch Subdivision

Introduction/Background:

The Pima County Department of Transportation received a constituent request to reset a No Parking sign that was knocked down within the High Plains Ranch subdivision. A review of the Pima County ordinance database determined that there is not an ordinance for the No Parking sign requested for maintenance.

Discussion:

Pima County Department of Transportation staff conducted field observations and determined that existing No Parking signs were installed along various public highways within the High Plains Ranch subdivision. No crashes were reported on the public highways within the subdivision in the past five years from 2015 - 2019.

Conclusion:

The Pima County Department of Transportation recommends that an ordinance be approved for the existing No Parking signs in the High Plains Ranch subdivision.

Recommendation:

The Pima County Department of Transportation recommends a No Parking ordinance be approved to regulate parking on the west side of Avenger Lane, High Plains Ranch Court, Drifter Ranch Place, Frontier Ranch Place, Stampede Ranch Court, Carte Blanche Court and the north side of High Plains Ranch Street in the High Plains Ranch subdivision.

ORDINANCE 2021 - _____

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF PIMA COUNTY, ARIZONA, RELATING TO TRAFFIC AND HIGHWAYS; REGULATING PARKING ON PORTIONS OF PUBLIC HIGHWAYS IN THE HIGH PLAINS RANCH SUBDIVISION IN PIMA COUNTY, ARIZONA

THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF PIMA COUNTY, ARIZONA FINDS THAT:

1. The Board of Supervisors of Pima County, Arizona has authority under A.R.S. §§ 28-627 and 28-873 as amended, to regulate the stopping, standing or parking of vehicles.
2. The Board of Supervisors has determined that it is in the interest of public safety to establish that vehicles should not park on portions of public highways within the High Plains Ranch Subdivision.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF PIMA COUNTY, ARIZONA:

SECTION 1. Parking on the west side of Avenger Lane, High Plains Ranch Court, Drifter Ranch Place, Frontier Ranch Place, Stampede Ranch Court, Carte Blanche Court and the north side of High Plains Ranch Street be regulated as No Parking.

SECTION 2. All other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are superseded to the extent of such conflicts.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect upon approval by the Board of Supervisors.

SECTION 4. Violators of this ordinance shall be subject to civil or criminal sanctions as provided by law.

SECTION 5. The various county officers and employees are authorized and directed to perform all acts necessary or desirable to give effect to this ordinance.
