Requested Board Meeting Date: February 16, 2021

Title: Parking Regulation - Crown King Drive

Introduction/Background:

The Pima County Department of Transportation received a constituent request to prohibit parking on the segment portion of Crown King Drive with raised median west of Mona Lisa Road. The constituent reported that there is not adequate road width for a westbound vehicle to pass parked vehicles adjacent to the raised median. Crown King Drive is a local roadway with a 25 mph speed limit.

Discussion:

Pima County Department of Transportation staff conducted a field review and determined that the pavement width on Crown King Drive north of the median is approximately 15 feet. Staff observed a vehicle parked north of the median that limited ingress for westbound vehicles. No crashes were reported on this portion of Crown King Drive in the past five years from 2015 to 2019.

Conclusion:

Vehicles parked on the segment portion of Crown King Drive with raised median may create insufficient pavement width to accommodate emergency vehicle access and restrict driver's maneuverability entering the subdivision. The latest edition of the Pima County Subdivision and Development Street Standards indicates that at least 16 feet be provided adjacent to medians for accessibility of emergency vehicles.

Recommendation:

The Pima County Department of Transportation recommends a No Stopping, Standing or Parking ordinance be approved for Crown King Drive from Mona Lisa Road to 200 feet west of Mona Lisa Road. The ordinance takes effect when and to the extent that signs are posted on the roadway.

ORDINANCE 2021 - _____

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF PIMA COUNTY, ARIZONA, RELATING TO TRAFFIC AND HIGHWAYS; REGULATING PARKING ON CROWN KING DRIVE IN PIMA COUNTY, ARIZONA

THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF PIMA COUNTY, ARIZONA FINDS THAT:

1. The Board of Supervisors of Pima County, Arizona has authority under A.R.S. §§ 28-627 and 28-873 as amended, to regulate the stopping, standing or parking of vehicles.
2. The Board of Supervisors has determined that it is in the interest of public safety to establish that vehicles should not stop, stand or park on portions of Crown King Drive.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF PIMA COUNTY, ARIZONA:

SECTION 1. Parking on Crown King Drive be regulated as No Stopping, Standing or Parking from Mona Lisa Road to 200 feet west of Mona Lisa Road.

SECTION 2. All other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are superseded to the extent of such conflicts.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect when and to the extent that signs are posted on the highway herein listed giving notice of the parking restriction.

SECTION 4. Violators of this ordinance shall be subject to civil or criminal sanctions as provided by law.

SECTION 5. The various county officers and employees are authorized and directed to perform all acts necessary or desirable to give effect to this ordinance.
