Requested Board Meeting Date: February 16, 2021

Title: Stop Regulation - Irvington Road and Joseph Avenue

Introduction/Background:

The Pima County Department of Transportation received multiple constituent requests to install an all-way stop at the intersection of Irvington Road and Joseph Avenue. Both roadways have a two-lane cross-section and 45 mph posted speed limit.

Discussion:

The Pima County Department of Transportation conducted a traffic control study at the Irvington Road and Joseph Avenue intersection as a result of the requests.

Conclusion:

The traffic control study determined that an all-way stop is recommended at the Irvington Road and Joseph Avenue intersection based on the crash and volume data in consideration of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD) guidelines.

Recommendation:

The Pima County Department of Transportation recommends an ordinance be approved to designate Irvington Road and Joseph Avenue as an all-way stop intersection.

ORDINANCE 2021 - _____

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF PIMA COUNTY, ARIZONA, RELATING TO TRAFFIC AND HIGHWAYS; REGULATING TRAFFIC AT THE INTERSECTION OF IRVINGTON ROAD AND JOSEPH AVENUE IN PIMA COUNTY, ARIZONA

THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF PIMA COUNTY, ARIZONA FINDS THAT:

1. The Board of Supervisors of Pima County, Arizona has authority under A.R.S. §§ 28-627 and 28-855 to designate stop intersections and to erect stop signs.
2. The Board of Supervisors has determined that it is in the interest of public safety to establish the intersection of Irvington Road and Joseph Avenue as a stop intersection in Pima County, Arizona.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF PIMA COUNTY, ARIZONA:

SECTION 1. The intersection of Irvington Road and Joseph Avenue be designated an all-way stop intersection.

SECTION 2. All other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are superseded to the extent of such conflicts.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect when and to the extent that stop signs are posted on the intersecting streets.

SECTION 4. Violators of this ordinance shall be subject to civil or criminal sanctions as provided by law.

SECTION 5. The various county officers and employees are authorized and directed to perform all acts necessary or desirable to give effect to this ordinance.
