Yes. PCPL was one of 20 Arizona Libraries to be accepted based on Census and Broadband Access data. PCPL's application was approved March 1 2021. PCPL has started the setup and orientation process. This non-cash award is a subscription to LibraryCall service to be piloted through September of 2021.
