HEPA filters are tested with particles that are 0.125 µm. Masks and respirators work by collecting particles through several physical mechanisms, including diffusion (small

particles) and interception and impaction (large particles) • N95 filtering facepiece respirators (FFRs) are constructed from electret (a dielectric material that has a quasi-permanent electric charge. An electret generates internal and external electric fields so the filter material has electrostatic attraction for additional collection of all particle sizes.
