CONTRACT AMENDMENT

The parties agree to amend the above-referenced contract as follows:

1. Background and Purpose.

Contract Amendment No.: [02]

1.1. <u>Background</u>. On 7-1-2016, County and Contractor entered into an agreement to promote and enhance tourism, business travel, film production & youth, amateur, semi-professional, & professional sports development and marketing.

1.2. <u>Purpose</u>. Due to better than expected increase of hotel/motel bed taxes this fiscal year, County wishes to pass increase to Contractor.

- **2. Term.** The Contract terminates on June 30, 2021.
- **3. Maximum Payment Amount.** The maximum amount the County will spend under this Contract, as set forth in Section 1.2, is increased by \$300,000.00. County's total payments to Contractor under this contract, including any sales taxes, will not exceed \$2,500,000.00.
- 4. Israel Boycott Certification. Pursuant to A.R.S. § 35-393.01, if Contractor engages in forprofit activity and has 10 or more employees, and if this Contract has a value of \$100,000.00 or more, Contractor certifies it is not currently engaged in, and agrees for the duration of this Contract to not engage in, a boycott of goods or services from Israel. This certification does not apply to a boycott prohibited by 50 U.S.C. § 4842 or a regulation issued pursuant to 50 U.S.C. § 4842.

All other provisions of the Contract not specifically changed by this Amendment remain in effect and are binding upon the parties.
