I request the following comment become part of the Agenda and ask that Agenda Item 30 supporting passage of H.R 1/S. 1 "For the People Act" be discussed at the Board of Supervisors Meeting of Tuesday 06-22-2021

I respectfully request all Supervisors vote against Agenda #30, Resolution #2021- 37, ballot measure (H.R.1) This bill ignores the National Voter Registration Act of 1993 requiring states make "a reasonable effort to remove the names of ineligible voters from voter rolls." It promotes mail-in ballots and ballot harvesting, and abolishes voter ID requirements and residency requirements.

A Rasmussen Reports national telephone and online survey in March 2021 shows overwhelming support for voter ID laws, finding 75 percent of all respondents, including minorities, favor ID measures. Support for voter ID laws has actually increased since 2018 when 67% said voters should be required to show photo identification.

Supporting this bill abrogates a state's right to make and enforce voter laws, harms voting integrity, and allows the Federal government to preempt a states' rights.
