## **PROCLAMATION**

**WHEREAS**, slips and falls impact people of all ages in Arizona, resulting in personal and financial tolls for older adults in Pima County and the health-care system; and

**WHEREAS**, slips and falls are the leading cause of injury-related deaths among residents 60 years of age and older in Arizona; and

**WHEREAS**, Pima County ranks second among Arizona counties in age-adjusted falls that result in hospitalizations; and

**WHEREAS**, the total cost — excluding those associated with physician care, EMS service, rehabilitation or long-term disability — for falls exceeded \$3 billion in 2020; and

**WHEREAS**, falls can lead to depression, loss of mobility and loss of functional independence; and

**WHEREAS**, older residents of Pima County need prevention programs that can teach them specific, everyday strategies to improve mobility and stability and reduce fall risks.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Pima County Board of Supervisors hereby proclaims the month of September 2021 to be:

### "FALLS FREE PIMA FALLS PREVENTION AWARENESS MONTH"

and encourages older residents to reduce their risk of falling and to promote health, safety and independence through participation in evidence-based physical exercise; annual eye and hearing checkups; medications management; and home-safety checks.
