APPROVED PROJECT SCOPE:

The Cienega Corridor Cultural Resources Survey will include identifying and inventorying cultural resources along the Corridor to gain a better understanding of prehistoric and historic times in this area. It will evaluate the impacts of erosion on cultural resources in this area, as well as the impact of human activities on cultural resources. Tasks of the project will include a pedestrian survey, ethnographic review, threat assessments, addressing research questions, a discussion of the geomorphological analysis, completing or updating Historic Property Inventory Forms for historic structures, and evaluation of any documented cultural resources for their eligibility for listing on the Arizona and National Registers of Historic Places. Project will be overseen by the Office of Sustainability and Conservation (OSC) and a qualified consultant.
